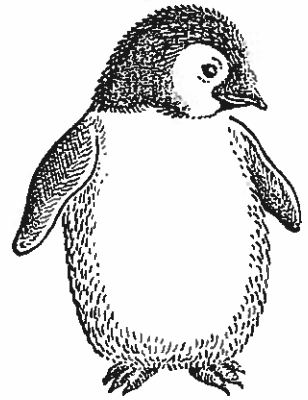

Then the fathers were ready to swim home. They were ready to help care for the baby penguins.

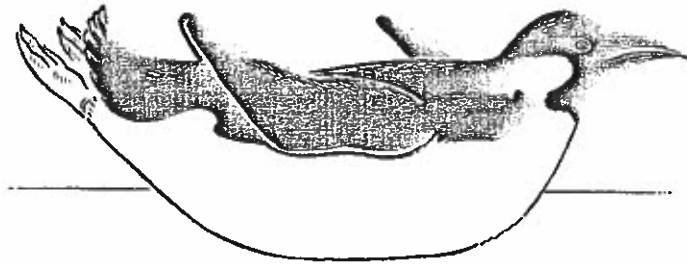
A shark saw fat Mr. Penguin swimming home. The shark followed Mr. Penguin.
