

Record Number of Online Jobs in 2020, Freelancer.com's Fast 50 reports

SYDNEY, Australia, 12 January 2021 - Freelancer.com (ASX: FLN), the world's largest freelancing and crowdsourcing marketplace by number of users and jobs posted, has announced a record 2.1 million jobs posted to its site throughout 2020 - a figure you can find alongside other stellar results in the company's Annual and Q4 2020 Fast 50 report released today.

To uncover trends in online jobs related to industries, technologies, products, and companies, the Freelancer.com Fast 50 Report tracks the quarterly movement of the top 50 fastest growing and declining jobs on the site's global online marketplace - spanning 247 countries, regions, and territories.

Freelancer.com taps into the best talent and ideas by connecting users with skilled jobs around the world. It is the largest freelancing and crowdsourcing platform in the world by number of users and jobs posted.

Headquartered in Sydney, Freelancer.com operates six global offices: in San Francisco, London, Vancouver, Manila and Buenos Aires. The company employs 500+ people globally.

COVID-19 PROMPTS STRONG GROWTH IN FREELANCE MARKETPLACE IN 2020

- The record number of jobs posted on the platform represents an increase of more than 17% year-on-year, growing from 1.8 million in 2019 to more than 2.1 million in 2020, as the COVID-19 crisis spurred growth for freelancing and remote work.
- This unprecedented surge in jobs posted to the Freelancer.com, can clearly be traced to March 2020, when the world was blown of course by the pandemic and when jobs and livelihoods were most at stake - showing that the platform and its marketplace plays an important role in ongoing economic recovery.
- "There will be a permanent step-change in both working from home and the use of freelancers by businesses", says Freelancer.com CEO Matt Barrie.



Programming and Web Development still rule

The Q4 2020 Fast 50 Report shows that 8 out of 10 fastest growing jobs in 2020 were in app development and website development - Indicating that businesses hunkering down during lockdowns have been using the time to improve their services, while individuals affected by COVID-related job losses and stagnant wages growth are starting up their own businesses.

Google's open-source UI software development kit Flutter achieved remarkable growth during 2020, with an increase of 320% jobs posted compared to 2019 (from 2,136 to 8,971 jobs). Developers use Flutter to develop applications for Android, iOS, Linux, Mac, Windows, Google Fuchsia, and the web - from a single codebase and at significantly reduced cost.

Other coding languages in demand were: Firebase (+182% to 5,365 jobs), Wix (+129% to 2,320 jobs), RESTful API (+112% to 3,362 jobs), Typescript (+92% to 2,428 jobs), among others.

The other 2 jobs rounding out the top 10 are also related to web and business development: Data Analysis (+116% to 3,500 jobs), and Physics (+105% to 3,138 jobs).

Physics specialists, especially those with MATLAB experience, are in demand for their ability to analyse complex multivariate data.

And the 2020 losers are...

In the midst of a difficult year, and despite the year-on-year jobs growth, some skills showed a marked reduction in demand as COVID-19 shuttered businesses and changed business models.

Demand for Help Desk jobs was down 74% (from 1,747 jobs to 457 jobs), and BPO and Order Processing services were down 65% and 64% (from 7662 to 2,704 jobs and from 1,971 to 701 jobs, respectively).

Grant Writing was also down by more than 60% (from 2,365 jobs to 855 jobs) as economies shrank and governments reached deep into their pockets and reallocated monies to subsidise wages and to support communities.

Q4 2020 Stats

 The upward trend in jobs posted appears to be continuing, with 524,000 jobs posted in Q4, an increase of 13,000 jobs compared to Q3. This indicates that employers, especially enterprise ones, are becoming more comfortable with remote work.



- Programming and web development skills have been the main winners of the Quarter, with a surge of 65% in R Programming Language (from 1,151 jobs to 1,895 jobs).
- Data specialists with knowledge of Algorithm (+53% to 5,792 jobs)), Mathematics (+52% to 5,850 jobs) and Matlab (+49% to 5,211 jobs) were also big winners of Q4 2020, where each day skills related to analysing complex data are being demanded more and more in the online world.
- On the other hand, XML (-29% to 1,022 jobs), Adobe Flash (-26% to 1,018 jobs) and Google Plus (-26% to 1,094 jobs) still suffer the consequences of lockdowns and social distancing, which have dramatically affected all tasks and skills where meeting, touching and sharing are needed.

Matt Barrie, CEO and Chairman of Freelancer.com, says "2020 has been a major turning point for the online job markets as a whole, as the COVID-19 pandemic has impacted the world of work and working models worldwide. Companies needed to adapt, almost overnight, to a new way of working, making COVID-19 the new "C-officer" of Digital Transformation within each company around the world".

"The freelance online job market continues to flourish in spite of global challenges. Towards the very end of Q1 2020 was the start of a deluge of demand and in Q2 to Q4 2020, the number of users that joined our platform, including freelancers and employers *looking* for freelancers, surged enormously. While COVID-19 has been the trigger of the already upward trending freelancer movement, this exponential growth can also be attributed to the strong desire for individuals to finally start their own freelance enterprise, work on their own terms and supplement their income. These are promising times and positive signs for the gig economy.", he added.

In June 2020, Freelancer.com jointly won the US\$25 million NASA Open Innovations Series 2 tender. In 2020, The U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) and Freelancer.com have teamed up to help crowdsource solutions to increase manufacturing energy productivity in the U.S. Other clients in 2020 that have teamed up with Freelancer.com in finding freelancers are Airbus, Novo Nordisk, Deloitte, Arrow Electronics, IBM Technology, Facebook, and many more. All of this shows how not only small-medium enterprises are using freelancers to get the work done, but also how major companies and organisations are implementing and hiring remote-freelance workers to help them with their day-to-day tasks.
