



Properly removing decorations

To avoid any fees for damages or room cleanup fees, please properly take down decor, throw it away and/or take it with you.

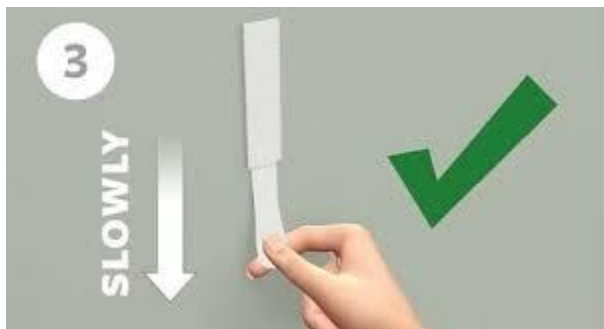
- Pop and trash any balloons used
- Take down and trash or keep any used banners or any other decor

REMOVING WALL DECOR

We often use command strips, tape and/or push pins when hanging decor on the walls. Please peel tape used off the wall and any push pins used and throw them away.

Please follow these instructions when removing command strips from walls to avoid damage to walls and paint.

1. Hold the Base Firmly-Gently hold the Command hook or mounting base against the wall with one hand.
2. Locate the Stretch-Release Tab-This is the white strip hanging at the bottom of the base.
3. Pull Straight Down-Slowly stretch the adhesive strip straight down, keeping it parallel to the wall. *DO NOT pull the strip toward you or away from the wall



4. Stretch slowly-Continue pulling slowly. The strip may stretch several inches as the adhesive releases; pulling too quickly can cause the strip to break. Eventually, the hook will pop off the wall.
- Never pull the strip sideways or up towards you; AVOID ripping the hook off the wall.
 - Do not twist or pry the hook off the wall.
 - If the strip breaks, carefully use dental floss or credit card or similar object behind the hook to loosen it; then remove any remaining adhesive gently.

Following these steps will keep the walls clean and damage-free.
