

## WORKSHOP SUPPLY LIST (please read thoroughly!)

**Portable Easel:** If you don't have one already, you might consider Art Box and Panel Co. (I have the mini version), Easyl, Open Box M or Strada.

**Umbrella:** (*optional*) To shade your easel when we're outside - I highly recommend Best Brella [www.bestbrella.com](http://www.bestbrella.com)

**Paint:** (suggested colors - I am currently using mostly Gamblin paints - DON'T buy hues!!!)

Titanium White  
Cadmium Yellow Lemon (*optional*)  
Cadmium Yellow (Medium)  
Cadmium Red (Medium)  
Alizarin Crimson  
Permanent Rose (from Windsor Newton - *optional*)  
Ultramarine Blue  
Phthalo Blue (if Gamblin, get the 1980 version!!!)  
Burnt Umber

And some kind of bag to hold them in - I use a gallon ziplock bag!

**Brushes:** I like Silver brights by Bristlon, sizes 4, 6 & 8 and a Silver Bristlon filbert size 2 for still life. For landscape I add in various other brushes - bring what YOU like - [www.dickblick.com](http://www.dickblick.com)

**Panels:** 15 - 20 small panels (whatever size/proportion you like). I recommend Gessobord by Ampersand from [dickblick](http://dickblick.com) OR soft cotton Raymar panels from [www.raymarart.com](http://www.raymarart.com) OR any brand that makes them with gator foam (lighter) - **AND** some way to carry the wet ones home (raymar sells wet panel carriers)

**Odorless mineral spirits:** I highly recommend Gamsol (if you're flying I'll have some for you), and something to hold it in (search [dickblick](http://dickblick.com) for "holbein metal brush washer")

**Medium:** (*optional*) I highly recommend Gamblin's solvent-free gel **AND** their galkyd gel for faster a drying medium (I use both outside)

**Paper towels:** The heavier duty the better (I get the blue ones from Costco) & plastic bags to put the dirties in

**Viewfinder:** I recommend a "viewcatcher" from [dickblick](http://dickblick.com)

**Wet Wips:** (*optional*) for cleanup

**Tablet or laptop computer:** IF it rains (let's hope not) and we paint inside, you will need something to display an image on to paint from.
