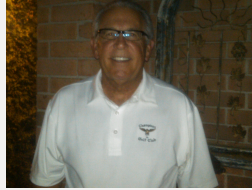
LARRY JONES

RULES OF THE ROAD:

- **Entry Fee - \$100 per man**
- **We play "desert golf" which means that anything in the desert or "transition areas" is playable; however, if the ball is lost or if the player prefers, he may take a drop on the closest grass area opposite (approx.) where his ball lies, no closer to the hole, with a one shot penalty.**
- **We play the 56 club rule, which means you may NOT borrow clubs outside your foursome, even if you are afraid you may scar your partner's brand new irons on a shot from the transition.**
- **Do NOT drive the carts into the desert areas! And if you are walking in the desert areas, be careful of the cacti...in over 25 years of playing this event, there has only been one guy willing to pluck a cholla barb out of an opponent's crotch area...it ain't gonna happen again...you gonna suffer!!**
- **Putts inside the leather are good, but long putters and wild imaginations are excluded!**
- **Tee times and dinner rezzies are hard numbers...if you dawdle, you're not going to play / eat....live with it. Shop / nap / swim / etc. some other time.**
- **Please be mindful of the format of each round. If you are out of the hole, continuing play will likely embarass our hosts and will DEFINITELY cut into some serious whiskey sippin' time...pleeeeze don't do it!**

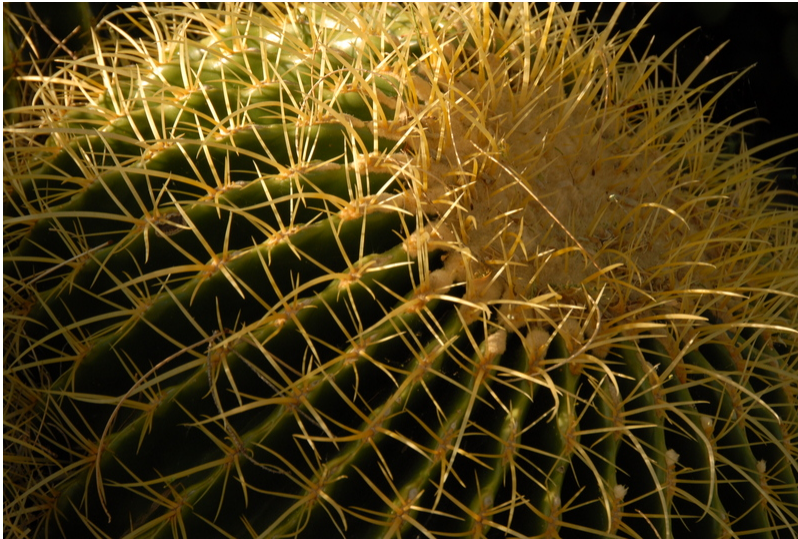

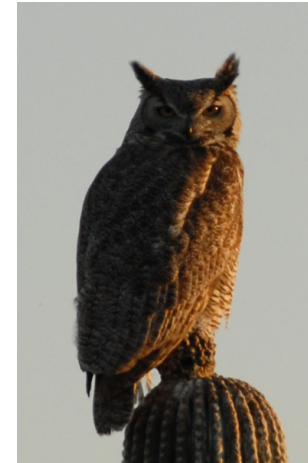

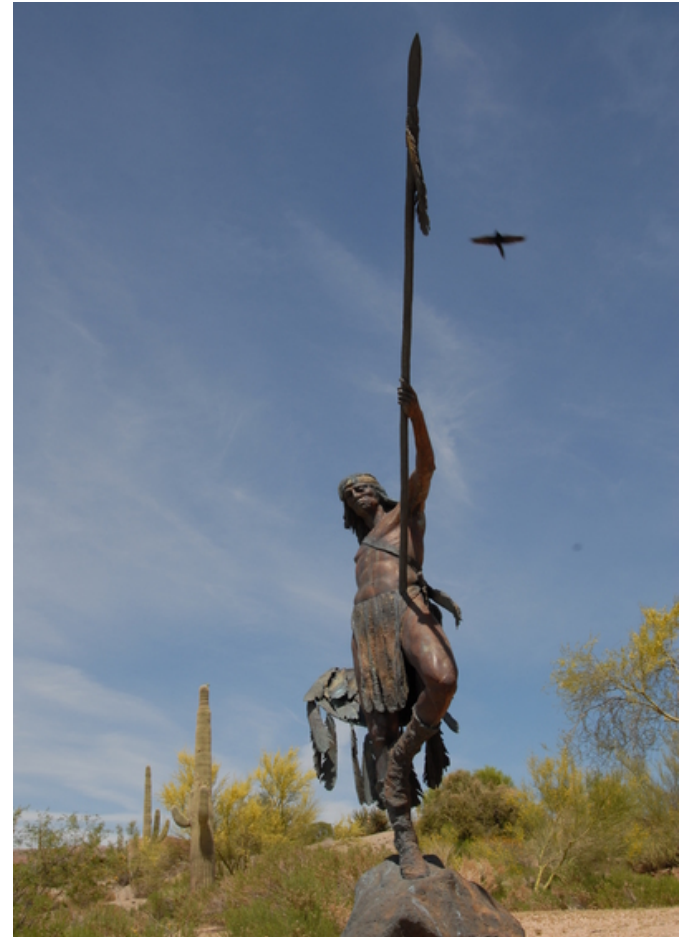
