From George in March,

Wellcome to this new system called GolfGenius. I thought we would give this a try this year to see how we all like it for selecting the pairings for the group as well as using it to establish varied golf matches for each of the rounds using each of our handicaps (or estimated ones). I trust all the information forwarded to me was as accurate as possible although based on some of the comments from your future partners I'm somewhat suspect. We will see!!

Below is a an attacment that Bob had sent us in December with all the information about the trip and the associated logistics. I would suggest we each review this and make sure we give a call to make our individual reservation.

*Hi guys...Hope all is well and you and your families had a wonderful Thanksgiving.....Well we are all set for Ocean City 2012. Below is our confirmation for sixteen golfers, arriving Sunday April 29 and leaving Wednesday May 2. We are staying at the same place as last year, the Holiday Inn Ocean Front on 67th St. We will play Bear Trap Dunes, a four star Rick Jacobsen designed course, on the way down. This course is located in Delaware about a half hour outside of Ocean City. Our group tee times are between 1:06 PM and 1:33 PM. They have a nice restaurant there, so those of you who are interested can meet earlier for lunch.*

*After playing our round, we will proceed to The Holiday Inn in Ocean City, check in and go to Ristorante Antipasto for dinner. On Monday we will play War Admiral at Glen Riddle, teeing off between 8:00 AM and 8:30 AM and those of you who are golf nuts, as I am, can consider playing a reload at Man-O-War on the same site. This will be extra. If you remember, last year we negotiated a price of \$50 per person for the reload. If the price is too high, we can always go down the road to Eagles Landing. I will work out the details when we get there. Of course we will eat dinner at Ruth Criss, on site, an excellent venue. Tuesday morning, we will play Lighthouse Sound, teeing off between 8:00 AM and*

*8:27 AM. Once again, I can look at a reload at that course or some nearby course such as River Run. The reload is not included in the package price below. Dinner on Tuesday is up for grabs. Last year George Greenwood found a great fish place. I will work with George on this. We do have some vouchers for \$50 dollars off per twosome at some selected Harrison Group Restaurants. We will see if there are any in that listing worthy of the delicate palates contained in our group. Wednesday, we will rise, check out, and ride North to Baywood Greens for our final round, 8:36 to 9:03 tee times. If you remember, last year we could not play due to severe weather conditions. By the way, I have the twelve vouchers from last year for those of us who got rained out. This will*

*effect the price as you will note below. For those of you who got rained out the package price will be \$578 per person which includes the hotel, single occupancy, and three rounds of golf only, since the fourth round will be covered by the voucher. For those of you who were not with us last year, the price is \$686 per person and includes the hotel, single occupancy, and four rounds of golf. When you call in to make payment, you will have to tell them whether you are covered by the Baywood Greens rain check voucher or not. This doesn't have to be done until some time in March and I will advise you again at that time. Joe note we are receiving the breakfast or lunch vouchers as we did last year. Maybe you can handle this again as you did such a great job with it last year.....I want to thank you all for responding in such a timely manner as to your interest. You will note we are up to sixteen players this year and I needed to make arrangements earlier to get back-to-back tee times for this many players at the quality courses we picked. It worked out great. Joe and George are going to try a more sophisticated wagering system this year. This should prove interesting and challenging. I am sure the laughs will abound. This is just for your information. Nothing has to be done by you at this time. I will let you know when you need to call in payment. If you have any questions, please let me know.*

# TOURNAMENTS

---

## LOW NET

**Round:** Sun (01:06 PM)

**Format:** Stroke, Player v. Field, Own Ball

**Handicap:** USGA Net

**Payout for each round:** 1st: 20 points, 2nd: 10, ... Nth: 5

This is our first round and we will play just a straight round of golf with each individual competing against the entire field of players. We will of course be using the provided handicaps to allow the system to calculate the low net winners. In this round you just put in your actual gross score for each hole and the system will incorporate your individual handicaps. The winners for this event will be 1st ,2nd, and 3rd low net with a payout of \$20, \$10, and \$5 respectfully. We will also recognize both the 1st and 2nd place low gross players with \$15 and \$10 purse.

## ROUND 2 - CHACHACHA

**Round:** Mon (08:00 AM)

**Pair by:** ABCD

**Format:** Stroke, Foursome v. Field, ChaChaCha

**Handicap:** USGA Net

**Payout for each round:** Winner takes all: 80 points

This round is called a Cha Cha Cha and the format is to count one best ball of the foursome on the first hole, 2 best balls of the foursome on the second hole, 3 best balls of the foursome on the third hole and then you just continue this process throughout the round. Again use your best ball(s) based on the gross score for each hole and the system will do all the calculations for the "best low net Cha Cha Cha". In selecting the pairings for this match the system uses everyones handicap and then splits the field into the top 25% of players, the next 25%, and so on. So the foursomes should be reasonably matched with 4 levels of players in each group (or as close as possible)

## BASIC NASSAU

**Round:** Tue (08:00 AM)

**Pair by:** AB

**Format:** Nassau-scored Stroke, Pair v. Field, Nassau (9/9/18)

**Handicap:** USGA Net

**Payout for each round:** Nassau: 20/20/20 points

This competition is what I called a basic Nassau and will be played using teams of 2 vs the entire field of players. The teams were decided using everyone's handicaps and the field was split into two groups of low handicap and high handicap and paired accordingly. Again, the system does its best on this given the unbalance of players (not that any of us are unbalanced). We will use the best ball of the pair to calculate the low net for each team on each hole and then for the round. The payout is based on the lowest net score for the team on the front nine, back nine, and then the total 18 holes. The payout will be \$20, \$20 and \$20.

## STABLEFORD ROUND

**Round:** Wed (08:36 AM)

**Pair by:** ABCD

**Format:** Stableford, Foursome v. Field, All Balls

**Handicap:** None (Gross) - 1

**Payout for each round:** Winner takes all: 100 points

This last round on Wednesday we will use what is called a Stableford. Each foursome will play against the others and will earn points from each player on how they did on that hole. A double bogey is 1 point, a bogey is 2 points, a par is 3 points, a birdie is 4 points, and an eagle is 5 points (can't imagine anything lower from this group). We are going to use actual Gross scores for this competition.

Note: We have organized these teams to represent the following: Lawyers, Financial Wizards, Market/Money Makers, and Operators. Based on previous days play, we will determine if any particular group should receive additional strokes or just "man up" and play the game!!
