Each golfer will play their own ball until they putt into the hole or they reach a score of triple bogey. **Triple bogey is the maximum score that will be allowed to be carded during the tournament.** If you want to record your scores back home, it is suggested you keep your own scorecard. At the end of the round all scorecards will be turned into Mr. Adventure. Mr. Adventure will post the scores into the computer at the end of the day and will announce the winners prior to the evening activities or prior to the next day's round of golf. Since this is not part of the Ryder Cup each person will put \$10 in the pot. Top Gross will get \$60, Top Net \$60, 2<sup>nd</sup>place Gross \$40 and 2<sup>nd</sup>place Net \$40. Plus 2 Closest to the Pins - Holes 7 & 11

Handicap: USGA Net (off lowest)

Payout for each round: Matches won/tied: 10/0 points

two ten-man teams and ten two-man matches. As in Ryder Cup fashion one member from each team will play a member of the opposing team in a match play format. The two-man matches will be determined by each team captain. In this format your total score for the round is not important. The golfer that wins the most holes in each match will be declared the winner of that match. Your opponent is allowed to concede any hole they feel they are out of. YES THERE IS STILL A TRIPLE BOGEY MAXIMUM SCORE **PER HOLE,** however, if one golfer putts the ball into the hole on the stroke that gives them a triple bogey and the opposing golfer does not, the golfer that sunk the putt wins that hole. If neither golfer sinks their putt within the triple bogey maximum, the hole is declared a draw. The golfer with the higher handicap will get strokes if there are differences in opponent handicaps. For example, if a 4 handicap is playing with a 12 handicap, then the 12 handicap golfer will get a stroke on the 8 hardest holes. If a 21 handicap is playing a 21 handicap, then there will be no strokes given and they will play even up. Each team receives a point for a

won match, one-half point for a tied match and zero

points for a lost match. The team with the most points wins. If there is a winner it will be announced at the conclusion of the final match. If both teams tie, the Mr. Adventure and Digits keep the prize money.
