WELCOME

The next two rounds are at the nearby private Gallery Golf Club South and North (former home of the World Championship) courses. We close at Whirlwind Devil's Claw course which is near the Phoenix Airport and has been host to the PGA Nationwide (web.com) tour.

TRANSPORTATION AND LODGING

Friday, January 31, 2014:

Flight USAIR 583, departing Columbus at 7:30 AM and arriving in Phoenix at 10:08 AM. The Dayton contingent will arrive in Phoenix at 9:15 AM and will pick up our 15 person van and meet the rest of the group at arrival pick-up. 

TOURNAMENTS

NET STABLEFORD

Round: Fri (01:00 PM)

Format: Stableford, Player v. Field, Own Ball

Handicap: USGA Net

Payout for each round: 1st - 50, 2nd - 25, 3rd - 15, 4th - 10

Day One is important round. It will be scored on a net stableford basis with: each net par, one points; each net birdie, two points; each net eagle, three points; and a net double eagle, four points. Since high scores do not count, it is acceptable to pick up balls and give putts to needy players. The winner from the first day will receive \$50, 2nd will receive \$25, third \$15 and fourth \$10. Ties will be broken in a fashion determined by Czar Blanchard. Results from the Day One Tournament will determine seeding for the Match Play tournament that will be conducted on the following three days.

SINGLES

Rounds: Sat (10:00 AM), Sun (10:00 AM), and Mon (08:15 AM)

Format: Match, Player v. Partner (1v2 & 3v4), Own Ball

Handicap: USGA Net

First Round Winners (Saturday) will receive \$25 each. On Sunday's matches, the winners' bracket winners will receive \$100 each; and the losers' bracket winners will receive \$25 each. On Monday, the winner of the loser's bracket will receive \$25. The two winners of the 1-1 matches will receive \$75 each and the winner of The Championship match will receive \$150 (for a total of \$275).

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. If a ball is hit out of bounds or lost or is in dangerous position (ask Sam about cacti), the golfer takes a two stroke penalty and can move the ball to a position no closer to the hole, but in a substantilly better position, i.e. the fairway.
- 2. The Czar reserves the right to change his mind (it is good to be the Czar) but the following are his initial thoughts on tie breakers. Day one, ties will be broken by reverting to the highest handicap holes on both nines. If that does not suffice, going to the second toughest on both nines, etc. Days two and three, ties will be determined on practice putting and chipping areas as determined by the Czar. Day four, ties will not be resolved, rather winnings will be split.
