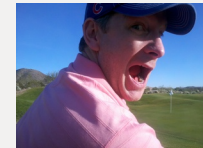
JOHN HENNESSEY

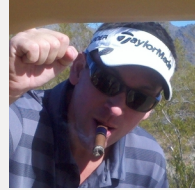
KEN CLARK

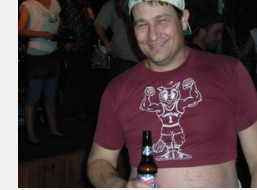
TODD GOVONI
