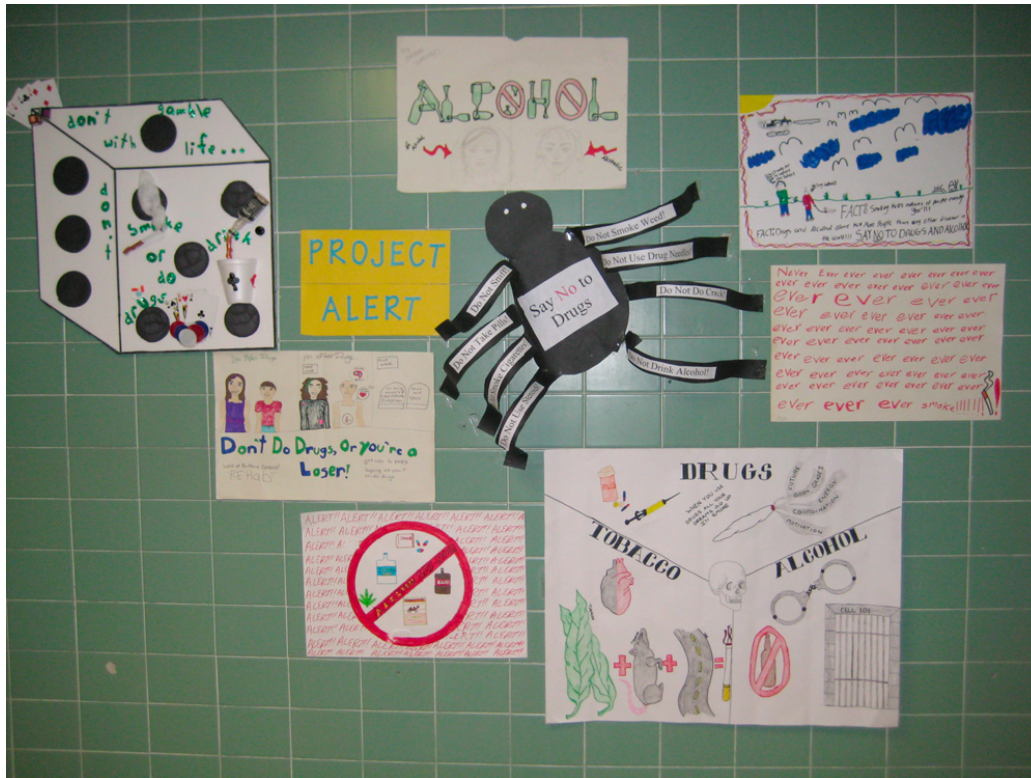


Poster contest expands Project ALERT
