

Match Procedures and Match Safety Regulations

Cold Range: The Redding Gun Club Pistol Range is a COLD RANGE! Guns are to be loaded only on the firing line under direct supervision of the Range Officer. Guns are to remain unloaded and holstered or cased off the line, unless in a Designated Safe Area.

Safe Areas: All Safe Areas are clearly posted. Dry firing, cleaning, repairs, and practice draws may be done in the boundaries of the Safe Area. NO AMMUNITION IS TO BE HANDLED IN SAFE AREAS. THIS INCLUDES SNAP CAPS, DUMMY ROUNDS, TRAINING ROUNDS AKA LASER CARTRIDGES, ETC. AND EMPTY CASES! Load your magazines/speed loaders anywhere else except the Safe Areas.

VEHICLES ARE NOT SAFE AREAS!

Function Test Area: The Function Test Area is located in the pit area near Shooters Services. It will be available throughout the match. A Range Officer will be available to monitor.

Uncasing and Holstering Your Handgun or PCC:

Uncase and holster your unloaded pistol in a designated Safe Area ONLY or on the line under Range Officer supervision. **HANDGUN HANDLING AT YOUR VEHICLE IS PROHIBITED AND WILL RE-SULT IN A MATCH DISQUALIFICATION UNDER USPSA RULE 10.5.19 PCC's** may be uncased and placed in a gun cart at a designated Safe Area, designated PCC Table or at your vehicle if properly flagged..

Obey Your Range Officers: Your Range Officers are here to make sure you have an enjoyable and SAFE match. If your gun handling becomes unsafe, they will take immediate action and order you to STOP. If the STOP order is given, immediately stop in place with your muzzle in a safe direction and finger off the trigger. Await further instructions from your Range Officer.

Hazard Areas: Please stay off the side berms and impact areas. Do

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES MAY NOT BE CONSUMED DURING THE

MATCH! Alcohol and recreational drugs may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors violating this policy will be disqualified and asked to leave the match area and Redding Gun Club.

Visitors/Guests: Anyone who enters Redding Gun Club and the Golden Bullet Championship match area must wear ear and eye protection at all times. This is mandatory for all competitors and spectators.

FIRST AID: First Aid will be located at Shooters Services. If a medical emergency arises please notify a match Range Officer immediately.

Weather: The weather in Redding during April can range from cool and wet to warm and windy. Please make sure you have the appropriate clothing available. WE SHOOT RAIN OR SHINE!

Restrooms: Portable toilets will be available throughout the match area. If a toilet needs attention ie; paper or service, please advise someone at Shooters Services.

Parking: Please park in designated parking areas only. Please DO NOT PARK IN RANGE OFFICER DESIGNATED PARKING, OR AREAS MARKED NO VEHICLES.

Shooters Services: First Aid, lost and found, match information, sign in, prize drawing, assistance with scoring issues, and any other issues may be addressed at Shooter Services.

Start Times: Start time for each day is 8:00am. *No shots may be fired before 8:00am.* The squad schedule has the start times for each stage. The written stage briefing will be read at that time. If an individual is late, they will have to contact the Range Master and ask to join their squad or receive a DNF for that stage.

Come Early/ Shoot Early: If the entire squad arrives early to a stage, the CRO will offer the squad the option to start early (except for first stage of the morning). If a competitor is missing, the squad will have to wait.

Procedures and Protocols

Match Rules: The current edition of the USPSA Competition Rule Book will be used. Unless otherwise noted in the course description, all walls are deemed to extend from ground to infinity. All targets, no shoots, vision barriers and hard cover zones are impenetrable to a full bullet diameter. Bullet holes that are partially or fully in the non-scoring border will score according to the circumstances. All walls and props are considered hard cover unless otherwise specified.

Classification: You must be a member of USPSA, or another IPSC Region to compete in this match. Your most current USPSA classification will be used. If you lack a valid, current USPSA/IPSC class card or your name is not in the USPSA classification record, you will shoot as unclassified. Please check and make sure your information is correct and valid when you check in at match. Senior=55+, Super Senior=65+, Lady=Female and Junior= Under 18.

Brass Pickup: This is a LOST BRASS MATCH. All brass belongs to Shasta Shooters and the Redding Gun Club, and may not be retrieved.

Dress Code: The use of offensive or objectionable garments or attire is not allowed. The Match Director will have final authority in respect of what garments or attire competitors are allowed to wear.

Course Inspection: When the entire squad is assembled, a brief stage walkthrough will be given by a four minute inspection and question period. Shooters may negotiate obstacles only during the four minute inspection period or while the previous shooters targets are being scored.

Early inspection is permitted provided the previous squad is finished.

Chronograph: Chronograph will be a part of Stage 1

Procedures and Protocols

Match Bulletin Board: Stage scores, messages, Arbitration Committee decisions, lost items, schedule changes and other official match information will be posted on the match bulletin board. The match bulletin board will be located adjacent to Shooters Services. Please check the match bulletin board frequently...it may be you we are looking for.

Stage Reset: Unless otherwise advised by the stage CRO, please make sure you keep your squad together and help tape and reset to maintain efficiency on each stage.

Changes To Stages: Information in this booklet is as correct as possible, however, owing to safety and production conciderations, changes may be made to any stage. Additional no-shoots will be added and other physical changes may be made that are not shown in this match booklet. It is the shooters responsibility to understand the stage and course of fire prior to the starting signal. Inspect each stage carefully and ask about any changes during your walk through.

Re-shoots: Range officers will grant re-shoots for Range Equipment Failures only. The Range Master must approve all other re-shoots.

Popper Calibration: Poppers will be calibrated before the stage is open and on a "as needed" basis. If you feel the popper is off calibration, call for calibration immediately during scoring, before anyone touches the popper.

Match Scoring: If you have any questions regarding your posted score, recheck your score sheet and your math. If you still think there is a problem, bring you're your score print out to Shooter Services and discuss the problem with the Match Director or Range Master. They will contact the Statistician and try and resolve the issue. **DO NOT GO DIRECTLY TO THE STATISTICIAN WITH A PROBLEM!**

Scoring Disputes: The shooter or their delegate should keep pace with the RO on each stage as he or she scores. Voice any scoring challenges before the target is taped so the matter can be resolved. Scoring challenges will not be entertained nor re-shoots granted after a target is taped. If you wish to protest the application of penalties or some other aspect of the stage, do not sign approve on your score on the tablet. Notify the Range Officer of the problem and ask the decision be appealed to the Chief Range Officer and /or the Range Master.

Arbitration Request: The Range Officer should handle scoring disputes on the stage if at all possible. The cash fee for submitting an Arbitration Request is \$100.00







PCC: UNLOADED, held with both hands, stock on belt.




