General Information & Match Rules

- General Information
 - Registration opens February 17th, 2019
 - Registration Link:

 - Setup Days: May 15th & 16th, 2019
 - Match Days: May 17th - 19th, 2019
 - Safety will be governed by stage and range requirements, each stage having a brief addressing any safety concerns and the course of fire.
 - Cold Range
 - Safe Tables will be in use, no ammo may be handled at the safe tables
 - Muzzle safe points; 180°
 - IDPA Range commands will be used
 - Concealment is not required
 - Match Fee: \$95
 - MAX 50 rounds per stage with a match round count of about 300... bring 400-500!
 - Mags loaded to 10 rounds max in all divisions except PCC
 - Reloads - any type, anytime and anywhere during the course of fire
 - This shall be a match governed by civility and sportsmanship. Abusive language or behavior will be grounds for an immediate match DQ and forfeiture of match fees.
 - Match Director will verify all DQ's.
- TARGETS & SCORING
 - Reactive steel must fall, and static steel must show a hit
 - IDPA cardboard targets will be used, If the hole touches a scoring zone line the better score is awarded
 - Each point down = 1 second added to the raw time
 - Foot Fault = 3 seconds per shot added to the raw time
 - Hits on Non-Threats = 5 seconds per hit added to the raw time
 - Miss = 5 seconds added to the raw time
 - Failure To Do Right (FTDR) = 20 seconds per hit added to the raw time, MD will be notified
 - Prizes/trophies will be awarded via the Lewis Scoring System i.e.; top third, middle third and bottom third of shooters.
- EQUIPMENT
 - Any IDPA or USPSA legal firearm may be used
 - Minimum Caliber 9mm.
 - Divisions
 - Iron Sights
 - fiber optic, night sights are allowed
 - 1st mag max 11 rounds, all other mags max 10
 - Optic/Open
 - Optic max mag length 141.25mm
 - Open max mag length 171.25mm
 - PCC
 - No magazine capacity limit
 - No power factor requirement, if the load will safely operate the gun and will not damage the steel targets it's allowed
 - Holsters, any IDPA or USPSA legal option
 - Mags/Mag Holder, any style you wish and as many as you wish
 - Belts, any style you wish
