

PRS SHOOT RULES

- **EVENT DETAILS:**
 - Event is Open to the Public
 - Our PRS Shoot is intended to be a fun and challenging event. The rules were developed using rules as used in other similar events local and far. The combined and altered rules were formatted to work for us to suite our range layout, as well as to allow any discipline of long range shooter to attend and be competitive. We may even throw a special event in. The special event could be a single round up to no more than 10 rounds. (Special event rules will be as specified the day of the event)
- **Registration:**
 - Registration open from 8:15 to 8:50
 - First relay called to the line 9:00
- **Cost:**
 - Cost will be \$15.00
- **Equipment needed:**
 - Firearm: Centerfire or Rimfire rifle in a caliber of .17, .204, .22, .243 6mm, .264 6.5mm, .284 7mm, .30 additionally we will allow .338 CAL however they will be in a separate relay after the other relays are completed.
 - Eye and Ear Protection
 - Rest, Bags, Bipod. Any free recoil system is allowed. (no Lead Sled type rests allowed) Rests, Bags can be shared between shooters on separate relays.
 - About 60 round of ammunition is all that's needed. A total of 36 round needed for score.
 - Spotting Scope, Binoculars & Tri Pods. Although not necessary but if you have them would be a great help is dialing in a friend or competitor.
 - Chamber Flag, Chamber Chiller or physical barrier to prevent action from closing.
 - Chamber Flags are available at the club for \$3.00 each.
- **Targets:**
 - Targets used will be IBS 50 yard rimfire targets rotated ¼ turn right. (name, relay, bench box located on the bottom right) Target box's 24, 19, 14, 9, 4 & S will be lined out as they are not used.
 - Each target box requires 1 shot, Box 1-5 are scored targets, Box 6 is a W/C used as a tie breaker only.
 - Bottom row box's 25, 20, 15, 10, 5 will be used for fine sight in shots. Dial in shots can be taken on the shoot-n-see targets below the row of fine sight in targets.
 - Bench/Position numbers will be located directly above the IBS target.
- **Scoring:**
 - Inward Scoring Method will be used. The highest scoring ring broken will be counted as the target score. "X" ring must be broken open to score a 10-X. Plug Gauges will be used to determine close shots.
 - ONLY 5 shots + 1 W/C may be taken at the 5+1 scoring boxes per relay. Extra shots in a scoring box result in "NO SCORE" There are no "MAKE UP" shots allowed!
 - Scoring will be completed by a non-competitor if one is available. Scorer and MD have the final call on all scored targets.
- **Flyers, Mistake Hits:**
 - Yellow card will be located at each bench position. If the shooter has a flier or mistake hit on any scoring box the yellow card is to be placed behind the shooter to signal the MD to be made aware of the problem and scoring can be adjusted accordingly. "MAKE UP SHOTS" are not allowed in any case.
- **Order of Event:**

- Each Relay will shoot there 3 strings at the shorter distance (rimfire 50 yards) (centerfire 100 yards)
- After all relays are finished the relays will move to the longer distance in order.
- Times for Relay:
 - 3.00 min Setup
 - 2.30 min Sighters
 - 0.15 sec Load/Make ready
 - 2.30 min 5+1 Score Shots (string 1)
 - 5.00 min Break, Action Open/Safe & Flagged
 - 2.30 min 5+1 Score Shots (string 2)
 - 6.00 min Break, Action Open/Safe & Flagged
 - 2.30 min 5+1 Score Shots (string 3)
 - Relay will clear the line at the end of the 2.30 min string to allow next relay to setup.
- Ready Cards:
 - Ready cards will be used to indicate the shooter is ready early!
 - The sooner a shooter is ready the sooner we can get the next relay on range. You will NOT be given extra time to get ready. However being ready helps all of us get done sooner.
- Spotters:
 - Spotters are encouraged to help call shots for the shooters
 - Spotters can also help call Flyers/Mistake shots on target
- General Conduct:
 - Anyone on the property shall NOT be Under the Influence of Alcohol or Illicit drugs
 - Participants and Spectators are expected to conduct themselves in a courteous and sportsman-like manner at all times. Any person or persons who violate these rules may be ejected from the event site at the Match Director's discretion with no refund!
 - Match Director may disqualify a competitor for any safety concerns.
 - Anyone caught cheating, altering a score card will result in a DNF on their score card.
