Dear Representative,

On behalf of our more than one million members from all 50 states, Susan B. Anthony Pro-Life America strongly supports and will score in favor of the One Big Beautiful Bill Act, which includes the vital priority of stopping forced taxpayer funding of the abortion industry for one year. Members of Congress must urgently prioritize swift passage of this bill.

The big abortion industry, led by Planned Parenthood, is a bad investment for American taxpayers—they are <u>focused on profits</u>, <u>politics and lawfare</u>, rather than providing quality services for low-income women in a safe environment. And Planned Parenthood alone is responsible for the <u>deaths of 402,230 unborn children</u> in just one year. Women and girls are far better off going to community health centers that <u>outnumber</u> <u>Planned Parenthood 15:1</u>, where Medicaid recipients and others can get better and much more comprehensive care.

In its recent 2023-24 annual report, Planned Parenthood reported over **\$2 billion in income and over \$2.5 billion in net assets.** Taxpayer funding in the form of government grants, contracts, and Medicaid reimbursements hit **\$792.2 million**, <u>over **\$2 million per day**</u> – an increase of \$92.9 million from the previous report and representing **39% of Planned Parenthood's overall revenue**. Taxpayers expect such massive investments of their hard-earned dollars to be accompanied by good outcomes, and yet the opposite is true. Big abortion's already abysmal track record only continues to decline: fewer health care services like pap tests and cancer screenings, but more abortions, more transgender "treatments," and more political spending against pro-life politicians. And the "care" they promise to women and girls is instead a culture of patient neglect, as reported by the <u>New York Times</u>, <u>Planned Parenthood staff</u>, and the <u>devastating news</u> of <u>deaths</u> as a result of botched abortions.

The bill also includes important family provisions, including enhanced childcare tax credits and new savings accounts for newborn children, which will help to ease some of the burden on moms—especially those considering abortions. We know that  $\underline{60\% \text{ of women}}$  who have had abortions said they would have preferred to give birth, had they only had better emotional and financial support.

This is the opportunity of a lifetime to save countless lives and spare taxpayers from forced complicity in propping up the abortion industry. Congress must not squander this opportunity and responsibility.
