

## Lakeview Crime Prevention District Meeting

September 25, 2025

### **Opening**

The meeting started at approximately 6:00 p.m. Board members present were Graham Ryan, Nancy Lytle, Brian Anderson, Ann LeBlanc, Susan Dineen, Andrew Koehler and Joe Rochelle. Richard Bordelon, Sudi Joint, and Sgt. Sam were also present.

**Motion to approve minutes:** Nancy moved, Andrew seconded and the motion carried.

### **Crime Report**

Sgt. Sam started off by saying there had been no persons crimes in 2025. From the 9/1-9/25 time period the following UCR crimes were reported: 2 auto thefts, 2 shopliftings, 3 thefts with a grand total of 7 crimes. We are down 47% in auto thefts this year. He noted that some residents are not being forthcoming about leaving keys in the car because insurance companies are denying coverage. In one of the auto thefts, two pistols were stolen. He then went over specific crimes.

There have been 534 traffic stops, 511 were let go, and only 23 were cited. Of those, only 3 were Lakeview residents. Traffic stops are up 158% from same period last year. It helps deter crime. Response time has been 6:39, which included 2:07 hold time and 4:32 response time.

### **Finances**

Sudi went over the balance statements and income statements. The City has been pretty current in billing. Accounts Payable is \$644K which includes \$570,831 in disputed millage.
