Announcing the Award of a Single Source Expansion Supplement to Community Action Partnership in Washington, DC

AGENCY: Office of Community Services, ACF, HHS

ACTION: Notice of award of a single-source expansion supplement to Community Action Partnership in Washington, DC, to create a new learning cluster focused on child poverty in rural communities and expanding access to multi-generational programs.

SUMMARY: The Administration for Children and Families (ACF), Office of Community Services (OCS), Division of State Assistance announces a single-source program expansion supplement in the amount of \$50,000 to Community Action Partnership in Washington, DC 20036. The supplement will support the creation of a new learning cluster focused on addressing child poverty in rural communities and tribal lands and increasing access to multi-generational programs. This effort supports a recent Administration initiative, *Rural Impact*. *Rural Impact* is a new effort, overseen by the White House Rural Council, to bring together federal agencies and

public and private partners to support a multi-generational approach to investing in rural families, communities, and tribal places.

DATES: The period of support is May 15, 2015 – September 29, 2015.
