Background: In response to the increasing number of accidents and incidents involving the Mitsubishi

MU-2B series airplane, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) began a safety evaluation of the MU-

2B in July of 2005. As a result of this safety evaluation, the FAA issued Special Federal Aviation

Regulation No. 108—Mitsubishi MU–2B Series Special Training, Experience, and Operating

Requirements on February 6, 2008. This Special Federal Aviation Regulation (SFAR) established a

standardized pilot training program. The collection of information is necessary to document participation,

completion, and compliance with the pilot training program for the MU-2B under the newly published

subpart N of part 91 which will replace SFAR No. 108.

Respondents: Approximately 600 pilots.

Frequency: On occasion.

Estimated Average Burden per Response: 10 minutes.

Estimated Total Annual Burden: 100 hours.
