Foreign-Trade Zone 122 -- Corpus Christi, Texas; Application for Subzone Cheniere Energy, Inc., Portland, Texas

An application has been submitted to the Foreign-Trade Zones (FTZ) Board by the Port of Corpus Christi Authority, grantee of FTZ 122, requesting subzone status for the facility of Cheniere Energy, Inc., located in Portland, Texas. The application was submitted pursuant to the provisions of the Foreign-Trade Zones Act, as amended (19 U.S.C. 81a-81u), and the regulations of the FTZ Board (15 CFR part 400). It was formally docketed on November 25, 2019.

The proposed subzone (1,636.109 acres) is located at 2822 La Quinta Road in Portland, Texas. A notification of proposed production activity has been submitted and is being processed under 15 CFR 400.37 (Doc. B-66-2019).

In accordance with the FTZ Board's regulations, Camille Evans of the FTZ Staff is designated examiner to review the application and make recommendations to the FTZ Board.
