The Whiting Committee and Advisory Panel will present impact analyses on the proposed alternatives for the southern red hake rebuilding framework action. After receiving the Plan Development Teams analyses and recommendations, the Advisory Panel and Committee will choose preferred alternatives to recommend to the Council at the June 23-25 meeting. They will also give a brief review of NROC/MARCO/RODA fishery dependent data project by Dr. Fiona Hogan and request for feedback. Other business will be discussed if necessary.
