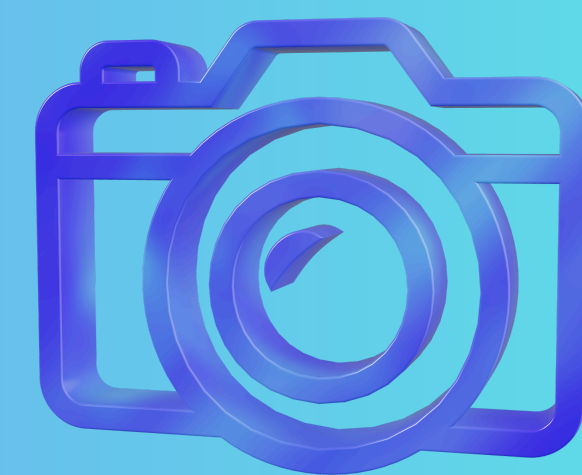


Shooting Task 1



The Elements of Composition

1. Take a photo that includes pattern and texture.
2. Take a photo that includes different colours, and one that includes only one colour.
3. Take a photo that uses leading lines to bring the viewer's eye to the subject.
4. Take a photo of the same subject from two different perspectives.
5. Take a photo into your light source and away from your source of light.
6. Take a photo of your subject, then it's shadow.

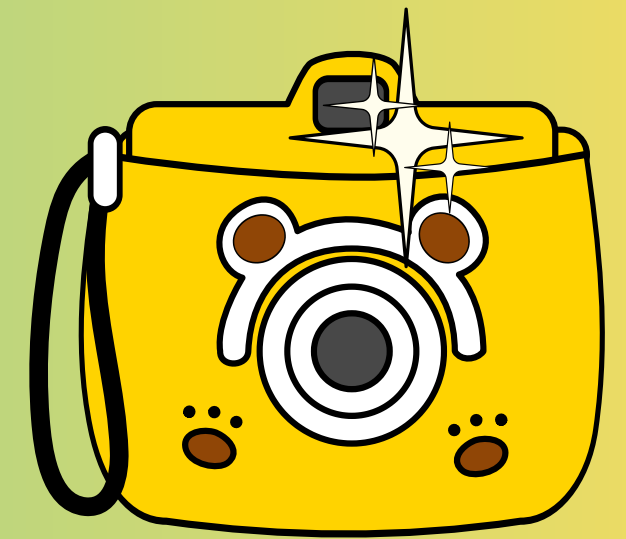

5. Take a photo of your subject that makes them look powerful, then weak.
