You must submit all application materials by 3 p.m. on Thursday, January 18, 2018.

Incomplete applications will not be reviewed. After the application deadline, your application will be scored and submitted to the Principal's Committee which is made up of Argo's Department Chairpersons. They will then determine who will be inducted into the National Honor Society. All decisions are final. Mr. Stern and Mr. Thompson are nonvoting members of this committee and do not determine whether or not you are inducted. *If you are selected by the Principal's Committee,* The National Honor Society induction will be on Wednesday, March 14 at 7 p.m. Once inducted, members are required to perform a yearlong service project along with a one-time service project each semester and any other duties as needed.

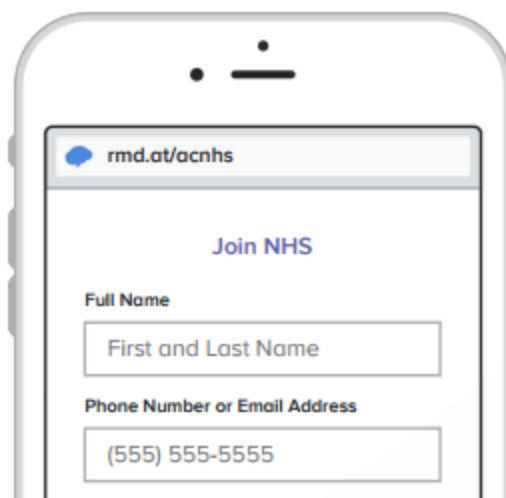

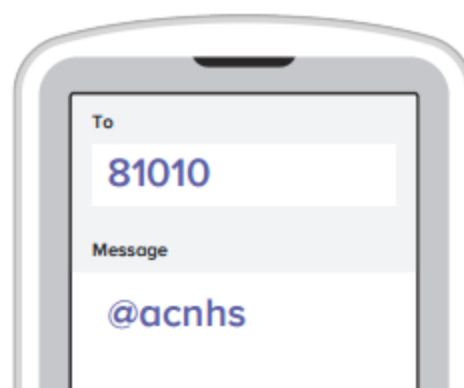
