

Grizzly Ticket To Play

Gravelly Hill Middle School is implementing a new policy on how physicals will be received and athletic eligibility will be approved. Starting the week before each season starts, student-athletes will have the opportunity during their lunch, after school and other time permitted slots to turn in their physical paperwork. If their paperwork is complete, they will receive a ticket to participate in try-outs. If their physical packet is incomplete, then they WILL NOT receive a ticket and CANNOT participate in try-outs until they return the completed paperwork and RECEIVE a ticket.

Who needs a ticket?

- Everyone who plans on trying out for a sport here at Gravelly Hill (even if they have already turned in a physical).

When can a student-athlete receive their ticket?

- The week before tryouts during their lunch (during the first 15 minutes), after school from 3:35pm-4:00pm or at the allotted time slot.
- Only on the FIRST and SECOND days of tryouts from 3:35pm-4:00pm

Who can collect a student-athlete's physical packet?

- The Athletic Director (Will Gehrman) or Assistant Athletic Director
- NO COACHES SHOULD RECEIVE A PHYSICAL PACKET (unless it is during the summer).

When does this policy start?

- Student-athletes who wish to participate in a Fall sport will have the chance to turn in COMPLETED paperwork and receive a ticket starting August 1st for Fall Sports (Football, Cheerleading, Boys Soccer, Girls & Boys Cross Country and Volleyball).

What's on the ticket?

- Tickets will be color coded by season
 - Fall Season-Red
 - Winter Season-Blue
 - Spring Season-Green
- Only the Athletic Director or Assistant Athletic Director will be able to sign off on the ticket (Not our signature - - - NOT A VALID TICKET)
- The student-athlete will receive the long portion to give to the coach and the short stub will be stapled to their packet.

Can a student-athlete turn their physical in earlier?

- Yes, they can but they will ONLY receive their ticket on the week before tryouts when tickets are being handed out.

Where do student-athletes turn in their physicals?

- They will turn physicals in to the Athletic Director's office near the gym.

What about off-season student-athletes?

- Off-season student-athletes can turn their physicals in every Tuesday and Thursday during intervention, lunch time or after school between 3:35pm and 4:00pm to the Athletic Director or Assistant Athletic Director.

What happens during the summer/beginning of fall?

- Student-athletes who will be working out in the summer will turn their physicals into respective coaches.
- The fall sports season tickets will be issued at a later date and time (look for future announcements).

What happens if an student-athlete plays several sports?

- If a student athlete anticipates trying out for multiple sports throughout the school year, they will need a ticket for each sport and they will get that ticket during that season collection period.
