Planning to join the Marian Central Catholic Fencing Team? Are you interested in trying out a new sport? The Hurricane Summer Fencing Camp is a good way to get a head start on the upcoming winter fencing season, and to try out a sport that relatively few high school students have the opportunity to enjoy. The camp is open to any middle- or high-school age student (6th-12th Grade) new to fencing. We'll meet in the Marian Central Auxiliary gym (West side of the building) from 5:00pm to 7:00pm Monday through Friday during the week of **June 14**. Fencing is a very complex and technical sport, so don't expect to become an expert in one week. We'll try to give you some idea of what to expect if you compete, and what to watch for if you're a spectator.

Instruction will be provided by Marian Central coaches, varsity team members, and alumni. Bring a good pair of court shoes and wear typical workout clothes. Water will be provided. Cost for the camp is \$70 and includes equipment rental. This will include jacket, mask, glove, and foil. All graduates of the Hurricane Fencing Camp will receive a t-shirt.



Why join Marian Central Fencing?



Fencing is a unique sport not found in many Midwest high schools. Marian Central is the only high school in McHenry County with a fencing team. Marian's team is part of the Great Lakes Conference and competes against schools from Illinois, Indiana, and Wisconsin.

The sport of fencing involves three different weapons, each with its own set of strategies and techniques. This allows fencers to explore their own athletic strengths and it encourages them to try new things.



Fencing is a fast-paced sport that is fun to watch and even more fun to do! It is both a physical and cognitive skill-based sport that teaches discipline, technique, perseverance, and leadership.

Members of the fencing team compete in both individual and team formats. This allows fencers to medal individually and to also earn trophies as a team. In its 21-year history, Marian Fencers have brought home over 40 individual medals and 4 team trophies.



Though generally an individual sport, the fencing team builds strong relationships and encourages leadership among participants.
