## **PROVIDENCE CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL INVITATIONAL**

Welcome to all participants of the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Providence Catholic Invitational. We are looking forward to a very exciting and enjoyable experience for the girls.

### **FORMAT:**

The six schools participating (Argo, Marian Catholic, Mother McAuley, Providence Catholic, Romeoville and Thornwood.) will play two games in their respective pools and then play a cross-section game on Saturday. The cross section games will be based on the seeding after the first two games. Pool A 1<sup>st</sup> place team will play Pool B 1<sup>st</sup> place team for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place. Pool A 2<sup>nd</sup> place team will play Pool B 2<sup>nd</sup> place team for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> place. Pool A 3<sup>rd</sup> place team will play Pool B 3<sup>rd</sup> place team for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place. This guarantees each team a total of 3 games. Plaques will be awarded to both the first and second place teams. This will be the same for both the freshman and sophomore levels.

All freshman games will be played in the Immaculate Heart Gym, while the sophomore games will be played in the Sacred Heart Gym.

Concessions will be available for all games.

### **TIE BREAKING PROCEDURE:**

If there is a tie

1. Head to head competition.
2. Point Differential – a maximum of +15 or -15 will be used so as to discourage running up the score.
3. Points Allowed
4. Points Scored – a maximum of 45 points per game.
5. Coin Toss

### **INDIVIDUAL AWARDS:**

There will be an all-tournament team at both the freshman and sophomore levels, consisting of seven players on each. Each school will vote for seven players (not including any of your own) at each level, and the top seven vote getters will receive medals.

### **AWARDS CEREMONY:**

All team and individual awards will be named at the conclusion of the final game of the tournament.
