PURPOSE: The Sam Flynn Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in 2016 to honor the memory of Samuel Tristan Flynn who gave his life on November 7 2016 while serving in the United States Marine Corp. Sam entered Rainier Christian as a kindergartner and continued throughout high school graduating from RCS in 2014. Sam's family friends, and Rainier Christian Schools desire to perpetuate and honor his memory by providing \$1,000 in financial assistance to a current RCS student who displays characteristics similar to Sam. In keeping with the family's priorities, the applicant will be an athlete who expresses the utmost respect for the military and those who choose to serve or a heart for pursuing a career involving military service. The scholarship is awarded annually to a RCS high school student and may be applied to tuition or athletic fees. The application is due 5/26 and will be awarded 6/5 during the awards ceremony.
