

Rosary Golf 2018

Welcome to Rosary Golf 2018! The coaches are looking forward to an exciting year for Rosary Golf that includes the return of a full conference schedule including a conference meet.

A mandatory parent/athlete meeting **for all Rosary athletes** will be held on Sunday, August 5th, at 6:30 pm in the Rosary Auditorium. Immediately afterwards we will have a team meeting in Room 300, At that time we will discuss the format for tryouts and practice schedule.

We ask that you please pre-register for the golf program by going to the Rosary Athletic Department website at <http://il.8to18.com/rosary>. In addition to registering, Rosary's 8to18 site also includes the links to a tentative team schedule. All athletes must register before the third day of tryouts.

Tryouts will be held Monday August 6th thru Thursday the 9th. For the first three days we will be utilizing Valley Green GC in North Aurora where all players will play a 9-hole round. **Tee times begin every morning at 6:30 am!** Coaching staff will arrive 45 minutes prior to the start of tryouts to allow for players to warm up on the range and the putting green. We urge you consider arriving early.

On Thursday the top 8 tryout finishers will play 18 holes, also starting at 6:30 AM (course yet to be determined). The first three rounds will be used to determine the qualifiers for this 18 hole round. Scores on this last round will determine the initial selection and ranking for the Varsity squad.

We will need an adult scorer to follow along with each foursome. In addition to recording scores they will assist with spotting for balls and helping to maintain pace of play. If you can assist please contact Coach Joe. We expect that we will need 4 people for the first 3 days.

The majority of our practices, as well as most home matches will be held at Valley Green. Practices will be 4:00 – 5:30 or 6:00pm. Practices will focus on all aspects of our game: short game (chipping, pitching, and putting), bunker play, full swing, course management, golf rules/regulations and etiquette.

It is expected that all Golf athletes will be in attendance for every practice. Players should be prepared for all situations; have proper attire for playing and practicing in all weather conditions, and have appropriate workout clothing every day for indoor workouts in case of a rain out.

This season, we have a new conference for competition, The Metro Conference and we will be hosting the Conference, at Blackberry Oaks on September 27, for both Varsity and JV.
