The *West Aurora Blackhawk Sports Booster Club* sponsors four athlete scholarships annually for senior scholastic athletes. The first two are awarded to the top male and female athletes. The remaining two are awarded to the athletes with the next highest scores regardless of gender. The Blackhawk Booster Club promotes scholastic achievement by its athletes by providing these non-renewable scholarships which will be presented at the Senior Awards Night on Thursday, May 16. The amount of each scholarship is \$500. The Boosters are giving a total of \$2000 in scholarships.

Please complete the Point System chart below. Additionally, each Student/Athlete will need to meet the following selection criteria:

- The student must apply by completing the point system chart below and submitting it to the Athletic Director's office for verification by **Friday, April 26**.
- The scholarship is for qualifying applicants to use for post-secondary education or training at a 4-year college or university, junior college, vocational school or trade school.
- Each student that participates as a cheerleader, a pom or has lettered in at least one interscholastic sport during their senior year is eligible. Spring sports, during their senior year, qualify even though they may not be concluded by time the selection is made. Completeness of participation will be verified.
- The student athlete must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) greater than or equal to 3.25 through 7 semesters.
- If the applicant is to receive a full academic or athletic scholarship for tuition and room and board, the applicant should decline selection or relinquish the scholarship. The Sports Booster Club will have alternate candidates selected.
