

# NCAA ELIGIBILITY CENTER ONLINE REGISTRATION

As a prospective college-bound student-athlete, you are required to register with the NCAA Eligibility Center if you plan on playing sports at the collegiate level in Division I or II. The Eligibility Center will determine your eligibility to participate.

The NCAA Clearinghouse is encouraging all student-athletes to register on-line by the middle of their junior year. To register, please follow the directions below:

1. Go to the internet and log on to <http://eligibilitycenter.org>.
2. Click on NCAA College Bound Athletes "Enter Here".
3. Click on "New Account" in the upper right hand corner or click on the telephone on left side and follow directions.
4. The WEST AURORA HIGH SCHOOL code is 140185. When you register for the ACT, use 9999 as the code to have your "official" ACT scores sent to the Eligibility Center.
5. At the end, click on "Submit Payment" even if you are a fee waiver student. Where it asks for your payment, if you are on a fee waiver at school, click on the blue "click here" on the right side of the page.
6. Fee waivers students see Mrs. Winslow - Honor House to complete the fee waiver.
7. Bring Mrs. Winslow this form with your Clearinghouse ID # to keep on file (make a copy of this form for yourself). Keep your Clearinghouse number and login info somewhere safe at home.
8. Send your official transcripts to the NCAA Clearinghouse at the end of junior year. (If you attended a high school prior to WAHS it is your responsibility to have your transcripts sent from that school to the Clearinghouse separately).
9. Sign into Naviance to request that a copy of your transcript is sent to the NCAA Clearinghouse at the end of your junior year. The registrar (301-5566) will mail it for you.
10. After graduation, request through Naviance to have your final transcript sent to the Eligibility Center.
11. **IF YOU TOOK OR PLAN ON TAKING SUMMER SCHOOL THROUGH WCC, YOU WILL NEED TO HAVE THOSE WCC TRANSCRIPTS SENT FROM WCC TO THE ELIGIBILITY CENTER.**

## IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT/GUARDIAN AND STUDENT TO:

1. Apply to the NCAA Eligibility Center online (the NEXUS CENTER or the Aurora Library has computers available for use if you do not have internet access at home) by the middle of your junior year.
2. Request through Naviance that our registrar sends your transcripts to update your file with the Eligibility Center at the end of junior year and after graduation.
3. Keep up Grade Point Average with grades of C, B, and A in CORE classes (D and F grades in CORE classes jeopardize your chances of meeting the QUALIFYING standards and your chances of obtaining scholarship opportunities).
4. Refer to <https://web1.ncaa.org/hsportal/exec/hsAction> for a copy of WAHS approved core courses.
5. Have your ACT scores sent from ACT to the NCAA Eligibility Center. The code for the NCAA is 9999.
6. Monitor current status and deficiencies through pulling up the online evaluation so that you can make changes in your curriculum if you need to with your counselor.
7. **MAKE SURE YOU ARE TAKING COLLEGE BOUND CURRICULUM AT WAHS: 4 years English, 3 years Algebra 1 or higher, 3 years Lab Science, 3 years Social Studies, 3 years additional core classes from any of the above listed areas or Foreign Language to equal 16 core credits for D-I and for D-II.**

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We (student/parent/guardian) have read the above items and will adhere to these policies. We understand that it is our responsibility to monitor the status of our student-athlete's progress toward meeting the NCAA Qualifying standards. If we have questions or concerns we will bring this to Mrs. Winslow's (301-5573) attention prior to student's senior year so that changes in curriculum can be made if need be.
