

## Registration Information for All Athletic Programs

Athletes can register in the athletic office during the following hours:

Monday – Friday                      7:15am – 3:00pm

**To register, every athlete must have the following:**

1. **Current Physical Examination** – The IHSA requires all athletes have a yearly physical examination. Physicals must be completed before a student/athlete can try out or practice with a team. We require physical examinations be completed before the first day of practice or try out.
2. **Student Information for Athletic Eligibility** – This includes general information about the student athlete.
3. **District #87 Athletic Code and Steroid Testing Consent** – Student athletes are asked to sign this Glenbard High School District #87 Agreement prior to each season in which they participate. A parent's signature is only required once per school year. The IHSA Steroid Testing Policy Consent to Random Testing form and the Concussion Information Sheet is also included on this agreement.

If you don't already have these materials, they are available in the Athletic Office.

**The following items are required to be turned in at the athletic office before an athlete can be given and Gold Card and cleared to practice or tryout.**

- Have a current physical (not older than 13 months) on file at the school or turn in a physical
- Student information for Athletic Eligibility Form
- District #87 Athletic Code Agreement signature page (both sides signed)

The participation fee of \$150.00 is due prior to the first contest. If you have a financial need, all arrangements must be made with Ms. Cartwright, Assistant Principal for Student Services before registration.
