



EXPECTATIONS FOR SPECTATORS IN ATTENDANCE FOR LAKE PARK ATHLETIC EVENTS FALL 2020

Lake Park High School is committed to the safety and well being of our student-athletes and staff. We are also committed to providing parents and families opportunities to see their student-athletes compete this fall. To that end, the District has created the following expectations:

Spectators at athletic events are expected to:

- Accept personal responsibility for following all public health guidelines.
- Practice safe social distancing.
- Stay home if you show symptoms or have been in contact with someone with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
- All spectators will wear a face covering and social distance at least 6 feet.
- All spectators must be at least 30 feet from the competition.
- All spectators will be required to complete a health certification form when they arrive on campus.
- There should be no physical contact or interactions with spectators and participants at any competition venue at any time before, during or after the event. Parents should not bring any food, drink or anything else to athletes.
- All spectators are encouraged to bring their own chair if they are wanting to sit to watch competitions.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring their own sanitizer.
- Abide by the rules of the host school when attending away events.
- There will be no spectators for girls swimming competitions due to state restrictions of 50 individuals maximum in indoor spaces.

Spectators who do not abide by the expectations of Lake Park High School, or individual locations where Lake Park athletic competitions are taking place, will be asked to leave the event.
