## ***Player/Parent Contract***

### **General Team Rules**

- **Be on Time**
  - To all practices, games, and team functions. If your late to practice without a pass you will not be allowed in the gym to practice and will be sent home.
- **Be Respectful**
  - Respect all coaches, officials, teammates, staff, both in our program and in other programs at this school and all other schools.
- **Be Prepared**
  - Have appropriate practice gear at each practices, and your uniform for all games.
  - Come ready to work hard each day leave all outside baggage off the court.
  - All away games come dressed in dress clothes and represent OEHS with class.
    - *Look good, feel good, play good!* (All levels will be in shirt and tie for any away contest on a school day).

### **Procedures**

**Unexcused Absences-** A player who misses practice without providing prior notice to a member of the coaching staff will be considered unexcused. A player who commits multiple violations is subject to removal from the team. Communication is the key; email is the best form.

**Excused/Unexcused-** Examples of excused absences would be illness, family event such as wedding, death in family or family emergency. All must still be communicated as soon as possible. Examples of unexcused absences include dentist, doctor, Bulls game, or vacation. *Understand missing practice will affect playing time and possible removal from team.*

**Attendance-** Per district policy a student-athlete must be in attendance for ½ of the school day in order to participate in a contest, the same will be upheld for practice. It is important that each player is at every game and practice, and if missing is communicating that to their coach.

**Code of Conduct-** Any code of conduct violations will be reported to the Oswego East Athletic Department and are subject to consequences laid out by the district code of conduct.

**Player Conduct-** The Oswego East coaching staff reserves the right to consequence players for conduct which is determined to be detrimental to the team; this includes but is not limited to: electronic media, in school conduct, conduct at school sponsored events, and school issued discipline. Consequences may include but are not limited to reduction in playing time, suspension, or removal from the team.

**Sportsmanship-** The players, parents, and fans of the Oswego East Basketball team are expected to demonstrate an exemplary level of sportsmanship. Parents and fans will refrain from directing comments to coaching staff, players, and officials.

**Communication-** Student athletes are encouraged to take ownership of communication with the coaching staff. If there is an issue which the coaching staff needs to be made aware of in regards to the overall well-being of the student athlete please contact us immediately. However coaches will not address questions pertaining to playing time, this conversation will happen between the player and the appropriate staff member. Our school has a 24 hour policy which means if you have an issue that may arise during a competition you should talk to your son after the game first and if there is still a problem communicate with the coach via email or phone call.

**Athletic Code of Conduct-** District 308 has high standards for all its student athletes and the athletic code is in affect 24/7 365 days a year.
