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The child is suffocating. The man fell to the floor clutching his chest. Suddenly the woman stops breathing. All of these common scenarios of emergency medical care and rapid response collide on a regular basis. Basic life support training equips those who respond to the call with life-saving and emergency stabilization skills. BLS Medical Certification checks training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation, commonly referred to as CPR, as well as using an automated external defibrillator or AED. BLS-certified individuals are also trained in how to assist victims of suffocation. To obtain BLS medical certification, register with a reputable organization such as the American Heart Association or the American Red Cross. Courses are offered across the country, with a link to find a curriculum near you available on the AHA and ARC websites. Some colleges also offer BLS training for those who become initially certified and for health care providers seeking continuous education hours and renewing certification. Many fire departments also provide this training to firefighters, first responders and health workers. BLS medical certification courses include PPC methods for all ages ranging from infants and adults. Training involves methods of saving one and two people. The application of AED to patients of all sizes is also taught, along with bag valve masks, life-saving breathing and choking care techniques. The American Red Cross offers an additional session on how to properly use asthma inhalers and epinephrine auto-injectors. The fee for the Medical BLS certification rate varies from supplier to supplier. The duration of the course ranges from a few hours a day of training to a series of classes. The American Heart Association offers some of the BLS training online. A practical demonstration of basic life-saving skills is essential to achieve BLS medical certification. The American Heart Association and the American Red Cross offer a course completion card after written and clinical trials have been completed. To prepare for the BLS certification exam, learn the BLS guidelines and manuals available online. For example, the New York State Department of Health provides bLS management with the practical skills of an online exam to respond to emergencies for review before testing. The American Red Cross also offers AED guidance specifically for first responders and health care providers. As with most licenses, medical basic life support certification must be renewed. Although the certification of the American Heart Association BLS within two years, like the American Red Cross certification, each state has different requirements for health care workers and the frequency of continuing education. For example, King County, Washington, offers annual seminars to update emergency medical technicians. BLS renewal courses require entrants to demonstrate level level and the ability to perform vital methods such as CPR and the use of a defibrillator. Applicants are certified at one of several certifying institutions after passing a national exam or meeting several experience requirements. Certificates expire. If you want to continue or resume work as a paramedic, it is important to find out if your certificate is still valid. You can do this with one of several methods. Certificates for paramedics are valid for several years, but the expiration date varies depending on the organization. The American Association of Medical Assistants' Certificate is issued for 60 months, and the Certificate of American Medical Technology expires after three years. Check your certificate for expiration date or use the issuance date to determine when to apply for an extension. Most certifying organizations provide access to certification records online. When you create an account, you can log in to check your status. If you don't want to create an account, you can check your certification details with a validation form provided to employers. This form allows you to search for your information with your name, Social Security number or certification identification number. Some organizations also provide a request form that you can email to your office. If the certifying organization does not provide online access to the records, you can call the office to check your status or submit a request. Provide your name, Social Security number and contact details. Health care providers must meet certain requirements to renew their certificates. If you find that your certification is nearing expiration date or that the certificate has expired, please contact the certifying authority to find out how to extend it. The exact duties of the paramedic vary in the from what type of medical specialist he works, but usually include taking vital signs of the patient, recording patient history, providing care with examinations, and preparing patients for procedures. Paramedics find work in all different types specifics, including clinical, administrative, eye care and subiatrics. Most paramedics work in general health facilities, in conditions such as doctors' offices, hospitals, clinics and health centres, and prefer to receive a medical certificate. Clinical reference programs cover general paramedic responsibilities such as patient card management, injections, ECG recording and taking vital signs. Certificate programs come from technical schools, vocational schools, community colleges and universities. They usually take one year to complete, with some programs taking just three to six months to complete. For a paramedic who is more suited to working at the table rather than with patients, the administrative help of the doctor's assistant is ideal. Administrative paramedics perform office procedures such as accounting and scheduling, as well as medical transcription, patient appointment planning and insurance claims. Certificate programs come from community colleges, vocational schools and medical programs, and usually take one year to complete. Some schools refer to their medical administrative assistant certificate program as a medical professional's office, medical office administration, or degree of health care management. Medical assistants wishing to work in a specialized field like subiatrics or optometry can earn a specialized certificate. Pediatric assistants complete a certificate program from the American College of Foot and Ankle Orthopedics and Medicine. ACFAOM offers a certificate program in conjunction with MediNail Learning Center, an online school that also offers certificates for licensed orthopedists. Ophthalmological paramedics are selected from several schools that sponsor medical assistant optometry programs. Ophthalmic certificate programs usually take one year to complete, and most require students to take part in internships or complete clinical studies with an ophthalmologist's office. Along with traditional class settings, paramedics can choose an online program. Online programs, such as those from the U.S. Career Institute, allow students to learn at their own pace from the comfort of their home. Depending on the program, online courses on medical care take from three months to a year to complete. Typically, students can only receive clinical and administrative certificates from an online assistant; most special certificates take place in a traditional classroom setting. According to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average annual salary of paramedics in 2016 was \$31,540. At the low end, paramedics earned a 25th percentile fee of \$26,860, meaning 75 percent earned more than that amount. The 75th percent salary is \$37,760, or 25 percent earn more.
