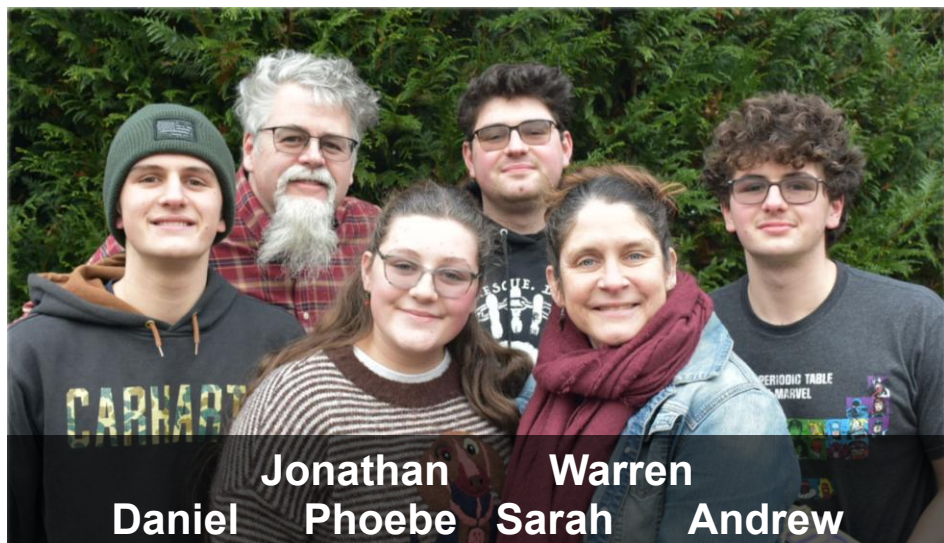


August Missionary of the Month
