December 2015

Identified opportunity to refocus our charitable aims, ahead of developing the next Union strategic plan

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January 2016

Appointed business consultants to help gain insight and create a business case for a review project

June 2016

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Union trustees approve project plan and agree the Union's new primary function and mission to 'listen to and act on the student voice'

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November 2016

Complete audit of Union business activities

January 2017

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Models developed to illustrate how a future Union may function

February 2017

Future Union models shared with over 3,000 students for feedback

March-May 2017

Pre-planning to inform the upcoming strategic planning process

Autumn 2017

Future Union survey open to all University of Portsmouth student

Spring 2018

Future Union Strategy 2018-21 drafted, based on student feedback

Summer 2018



We will know about the entirety of our student community - including all those students outside of the 18-21 campus based demographic - and discover what they need and want from their university experience.




ACTIONS

We will act on the information from our insight gathering activities. Providing opportunities for our student community to engage with projects, events, campaigns and services that are relevant to them.


FLEXIBILITY





What is this consultation about?

For several years, the University has provided staff with the technology to record video and/or audio for the purpose of extending teaching and learning activity beyond the confines of the classroom. This has included the provision of limited lecture capture technology in some large lecture theatres, as well as providing access to software that allows staff to produce learning materials on their computers. 
