# CHURN DASH QUILT PATTERN

---

Cutting the four corner squares diagonally, and the four side squares horizontally, and leaving the middle square whole produces the Churn Dash pattern. Originating between 1900 and 1950, this block represents a butter churn (the outside blocks) and the center stick, or “dash.”

Like many other blocks, the Churn Dash has many other variations and names.
