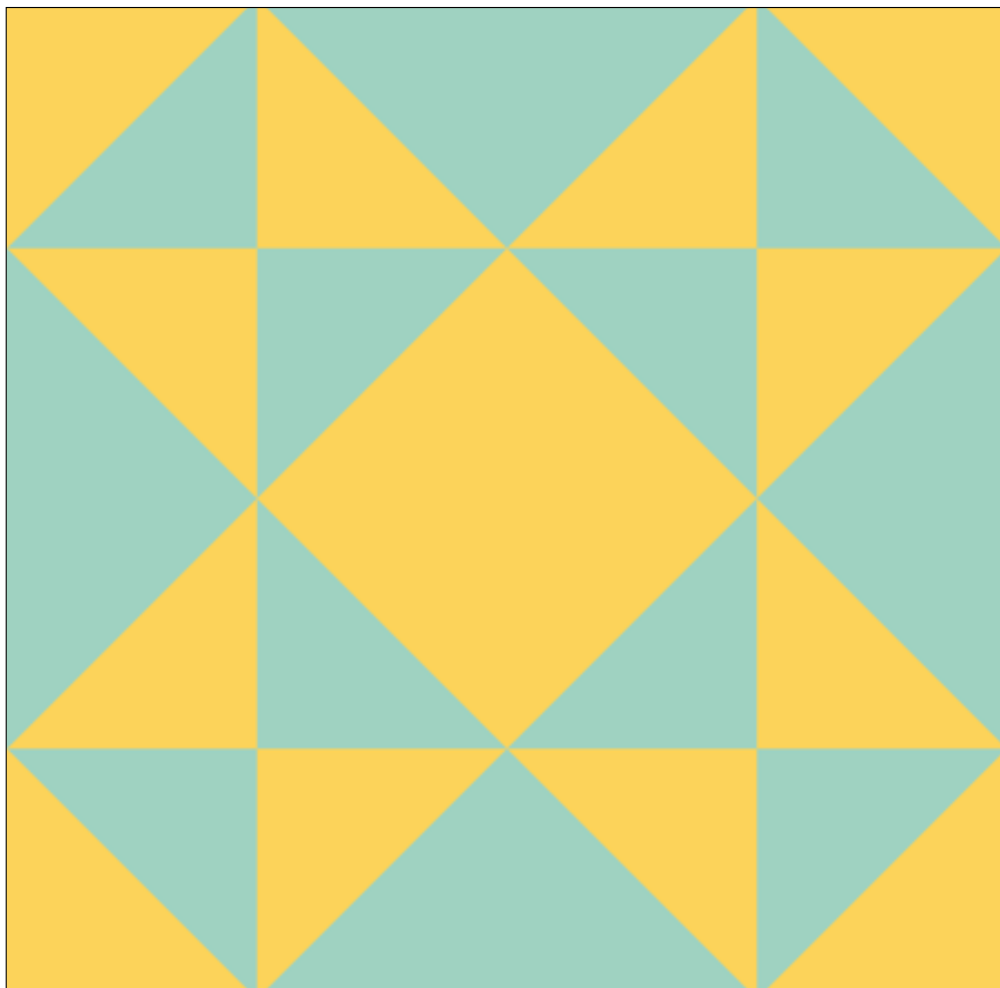




SAW TOOTH QUILT PATTERN

This pattern uses 16 squares instead of nine. The four-by-four block consists of one oversized square in the middle (a two-by-two square), a solid square in each corner, and side squares cut in half diagonally. Like many quilt blocks, its name comes from common items found around the homestead.
