A year later, I organized my own ride from Hong Kong, a 550km cycling challenge from Saigon to Siem Reap with 12 riders, all fundraising for the Somaly Mam Foundation. To cut a long story short, the Foundation no longer exists but after visiting "Haven Cambodia," the most divine restaurant, with my Mum in late 2013, I now support Haven Cambodia which is a training restaurant for a fortunate handful of impoverished and underprivileged teens from the poorest areas. When they "come of age" to make way for the younger kids in the orphanages and shelters, they have to leave and could end up exploited or even sold. When I returned, I couldn't sit back and do nothing, and I'll always support those less fortunate. When I brought one of the bracelets I now sell, I had so many compliments and friends started asking for custom made pieces. It dawned on me that perhaps I could sell them and at the same time, raise funds for "Haven Cambodia" and that's exactly what I'm doing and I'm thrilled.
