

Contract Position Physiotherapist

Description:

Racquetball Canada requires a Physiotherapist for Team Canada at the 2020 Pan Am Championships – location TBD. These services are effective from April 1 to 12, 2020. The Physiotherapist reports directly to Team Canada's Head and Assistant Coach.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Oversee and provide expertise on medical/physio needs before, during and after team member's matches.
- Liaise with Team Canada athletes and coaches during and preceding the event.
- Attend team practices.
- Attend coach/players meetings when required.
- Be up to date on athletes' daily schedules.
- Provide the Racquetball Canada High Performance and Sport Development Administrator with a written program evaluation and summary report within 3 weeks of the event's conclusion.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Registered Physiotherapist (credentials to be provided).
- Has and provides confirmation of liability insurance.
- Provide an up to date criminal background check.
- Agree to abide by Racquetball Canada policies and codes of conduct.
- Knowledge of Racquetball is an asset.
- Demonstrated ability to work effectively with athletes.
- Strong organizational and interpersonal skills, ability to multi-task. Excellent oral and written communication skills with a results-orientated approach.
- Flexibility in work hours.
- Previous experience in multi-sport international games is an asset.
- Bilingualism (English and French) is a definite asset but is not a requirement.

Compensation:

- The contract is in the amount of \$2,000 paid out in two increments \$1,000 on March 23, 2020 and \$1,000 upon receipt of the final summary report.
- The cost of an economy air travel to and from the tournament location and the cost of the excess baggage fees associated with the treatment table and supplies.
- Hotel accommodations to a maximum of 11 nights. Racquetball Canada will pay the hotel directly.
- Provide a per diem of up to \$50 CDN for a maximum of 12 days at the event.
- Compensation for any materials used in the treatment of athletes on a reimbursement basis.
- Racquetball Canada will provide the successful candidate with a team uniform.
- In emergency situations Racquetball Canada will consider covering additional expenses.
