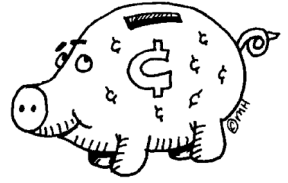

1st Grade Math Fact Challenge

Dear Families,

Simple addition and subtraction facts are one of the many routines children work with regularly in "Investigations" through various activities and explorations. Being able to recall basic number facts, such as $7+6$ or $3+2$ with speed and accuracy is an important part of mathematics and it involves frequent practice.

In order to increase the speed and accuracy of our First Grade students, we will begin our "Math Fact Challenge". Our expectation is that the students be able to quickly and accurately complete 20 addition and subtraction facts. Every Friday, students will be given an addition assessment that will increase in difficulty using addition facts where the sum is less than or equal to eighteen.

Multiple shortcuts for learning addition facts will be introduced. One shortcut is the Turn-Around Rule, which states that the order in which numbers are added does not change the sum. For Example, $4+3$ and $3+4$ both equal 7. Your child will also learn the meaning of adding 0 and 1 to any number. Knowing these shortcuts will make the task of learning addition facts easier.

We encourage you to help your child with addition and subtraction facts at home over the summer. Please use the "Math Minutes" grid to keep track of how many minutes your child practices facts. Color a box for each minute. When the grid is completely covered (100 minutes) have your child bring their "Math Minutes" to their classroom teacher to get a special surprise!
