Plot Summary

Mit is at the end of a pier and sees a fish in the ocean. He gets Mat and Sam to help him catch the fish. Mit falls into the water and then Mat does too. Sam rescues them with a net and at the same time hauls in the fish. But the fish is unhappy out of the water, so Mit throws him back into the ocean.

Story Questions (Comprehension)

1. page 2: What does Mit see in the water?
2. page 5: What is Mit using to catch the fish?
3. pages 5-8: What happens to Mit and Mat when they try to catch the fish?
4. page 9: Who is going to rescue them?
5. page 13: What will make the fish feel well again?

Each new word throughout the program is repeated at least five times in the book in which it first appears and five more times in the next ten books.

In 1972, the federally funded Southwest Regional Laboratory for Educational Development & Research and Ginn and Company published The Sam Books of early readers as part of a Beginning Reading Program. Because it was federally funded, federal law required the program be placed in the public domain in 1977.
