Story Questions (Comprehension)

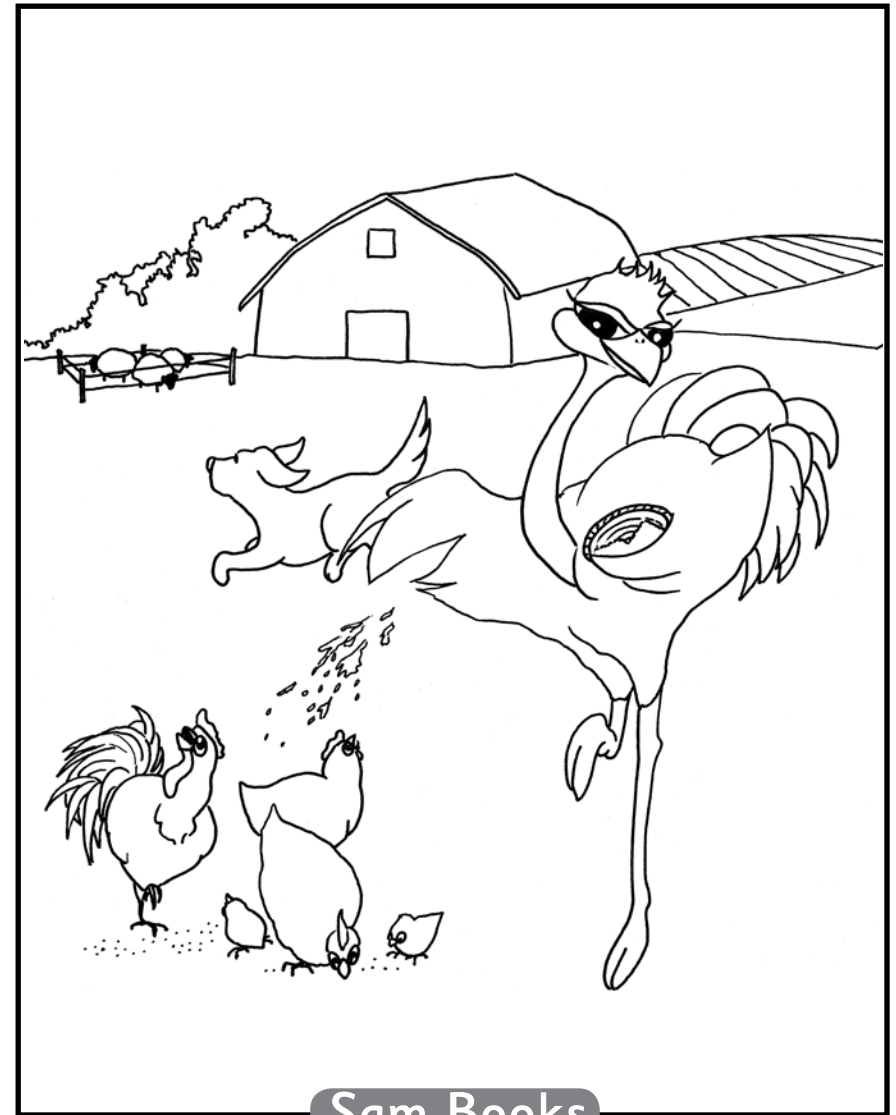
1. page 1: Why does Sam want to visit the farm?

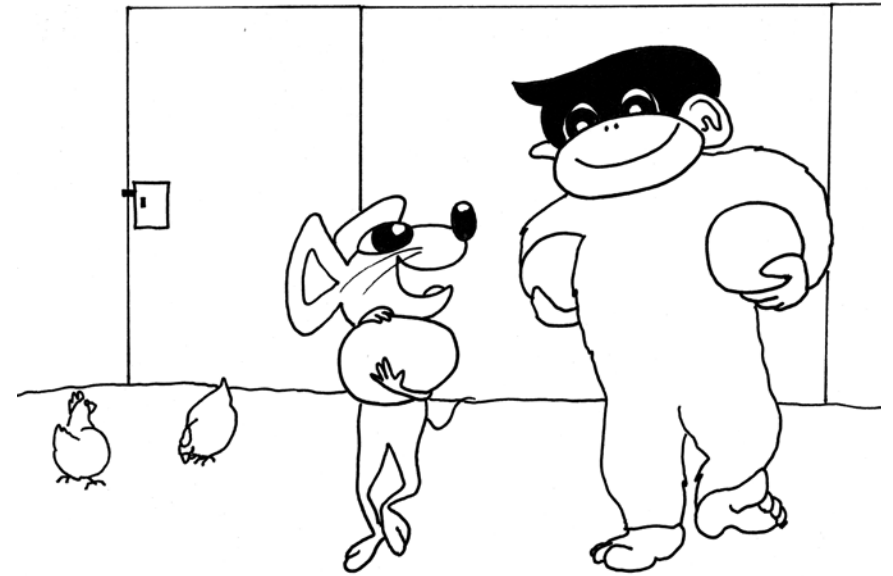
“We need to go.
It is very far to get back.”



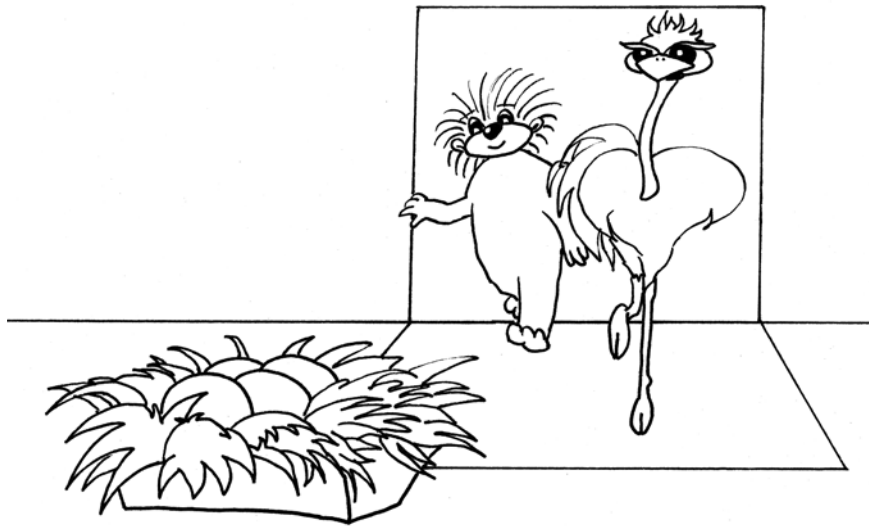
“Today, we will go to the farm.

They are in the barn.”

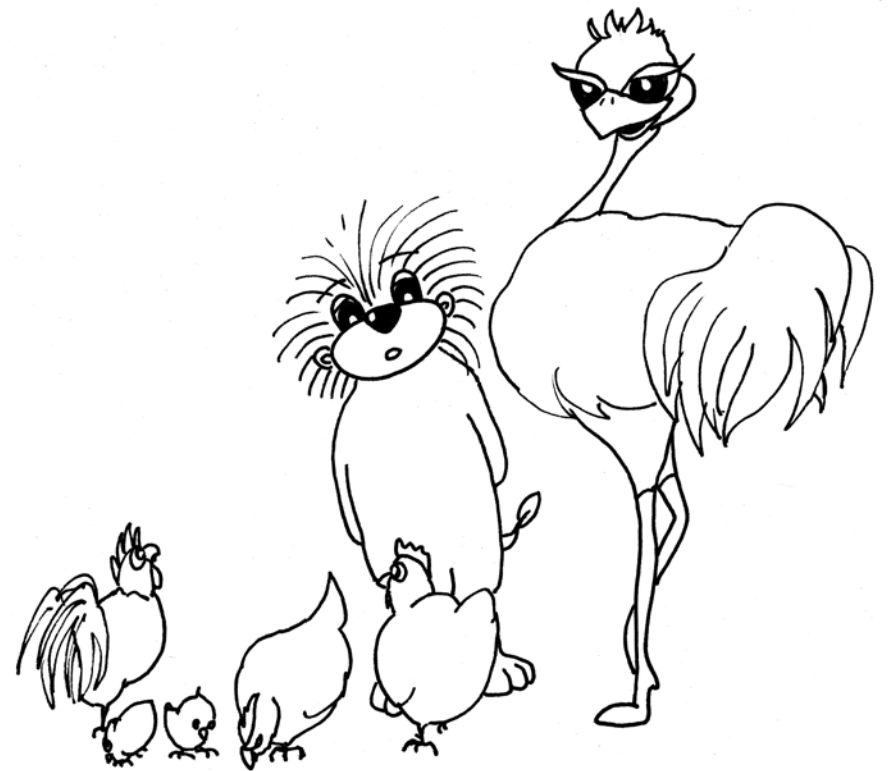


“We can sing this song as we go.”

Is my hand on my chin?”



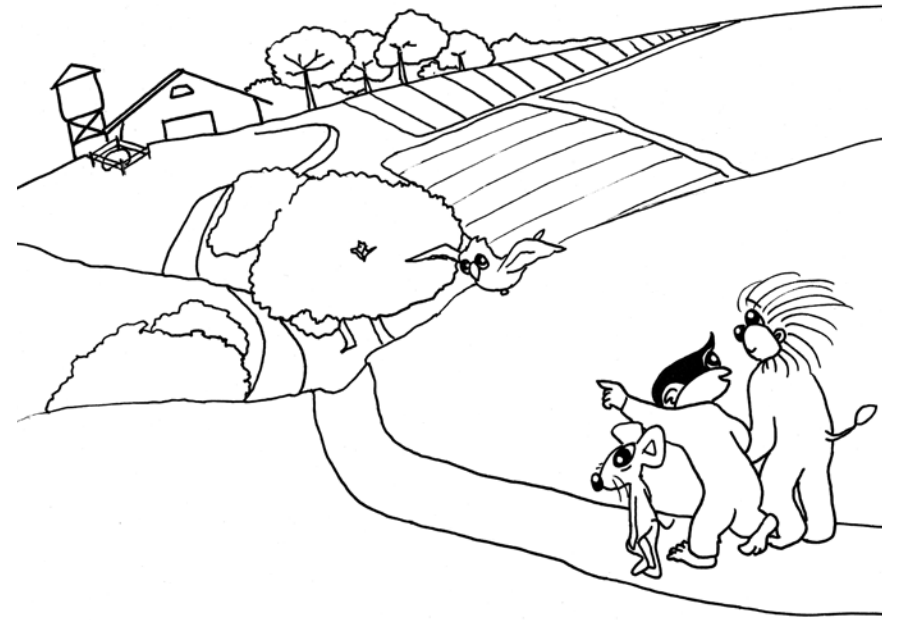
“That is a fun song.
Did you make it up?” Says Mat.



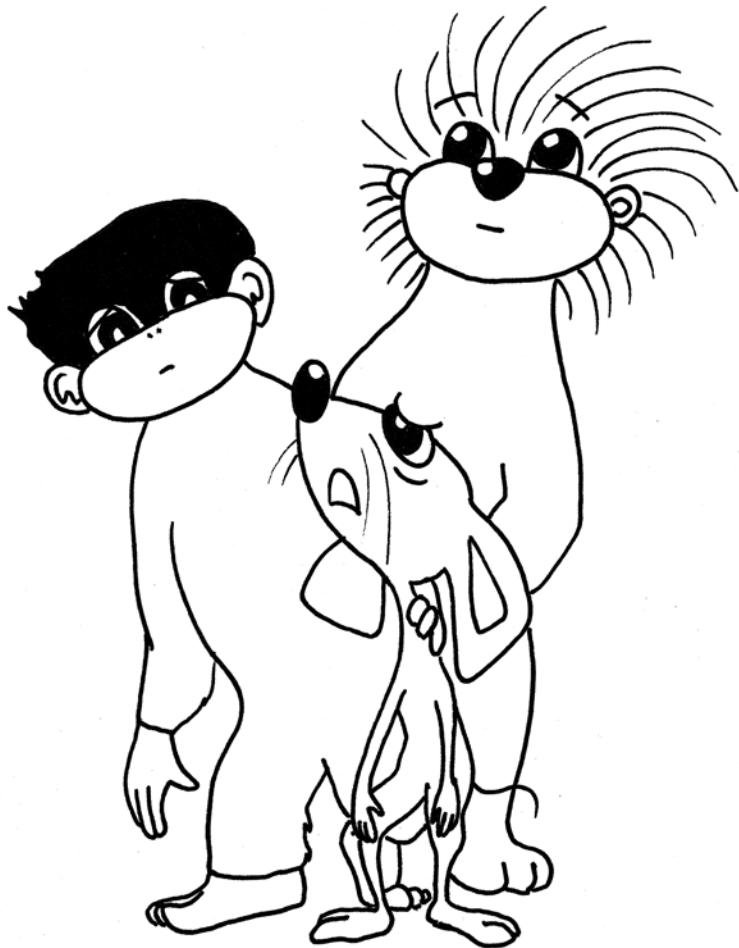
“Nell, we need a big box of farm eggs.”

They did not lay eggs today.”



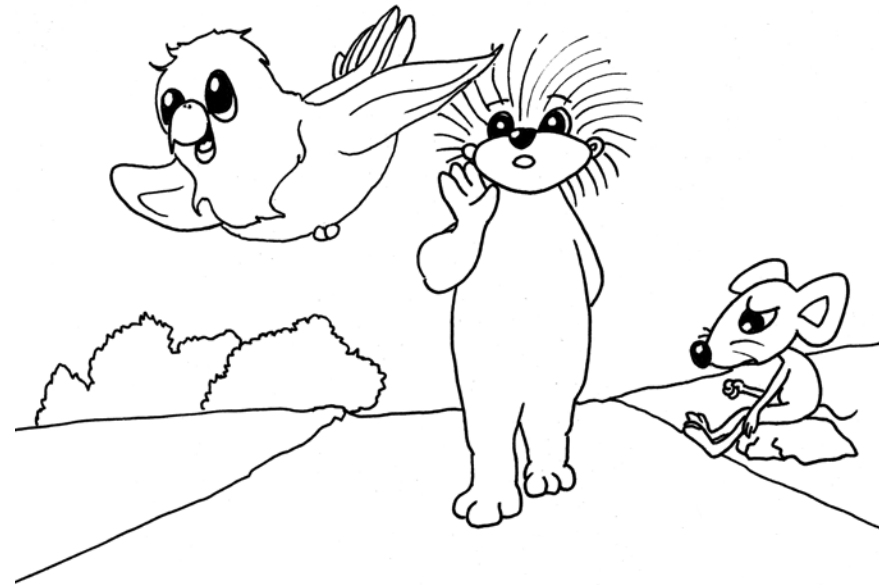
They get to the barn.
