5. page 14: Did Mat and Kit find Zip the zebra?

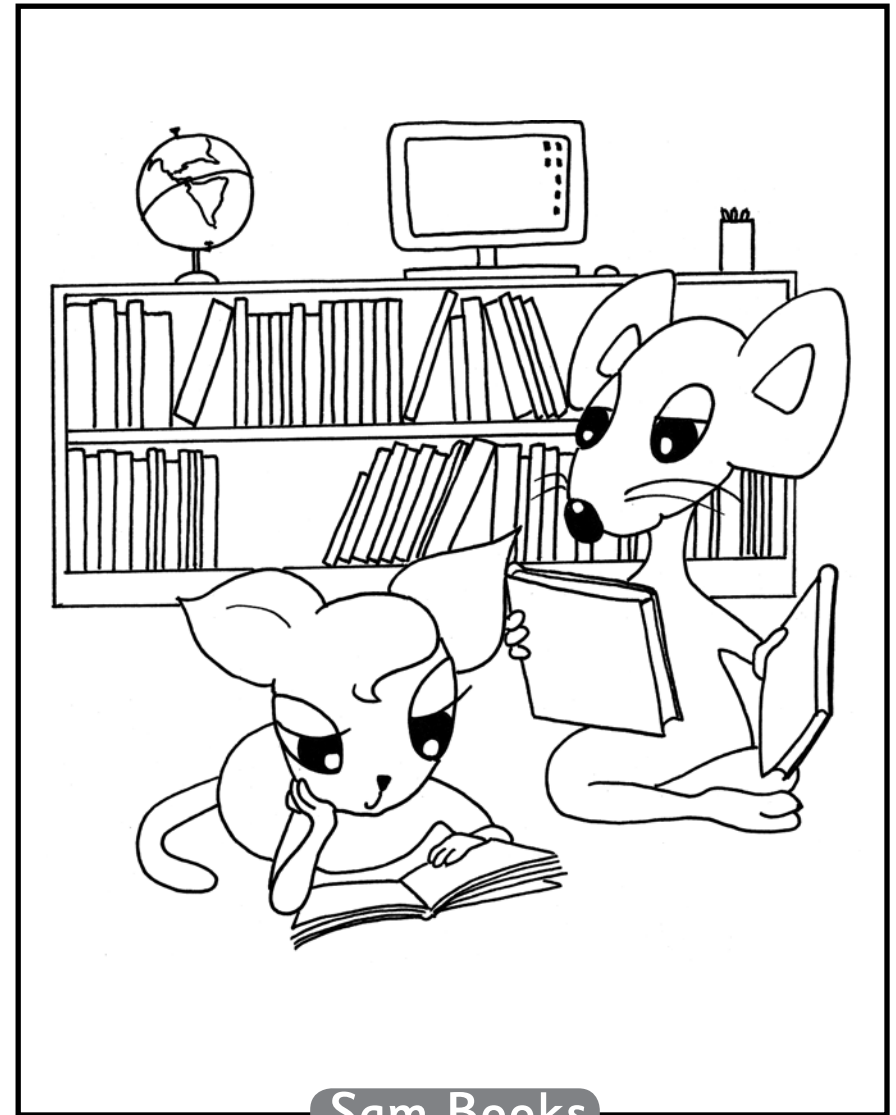
Each new word throughout the program is repeated at least five times in the book in which it first appears and five more times in the next ten books.

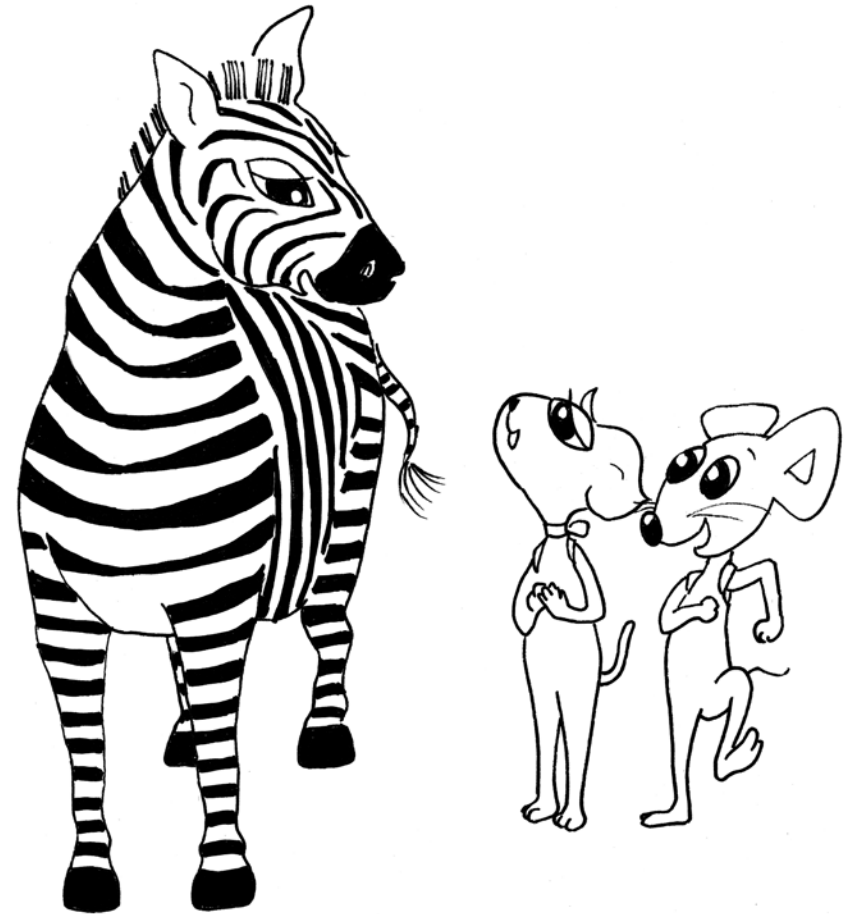

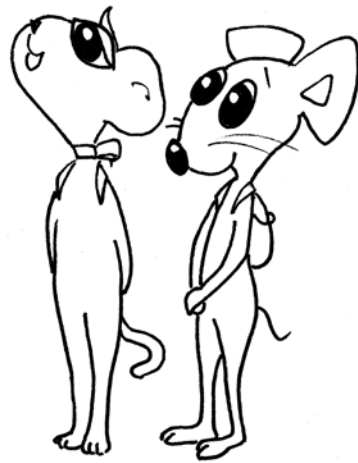


“There is no Zip the Zebra in this zoo.

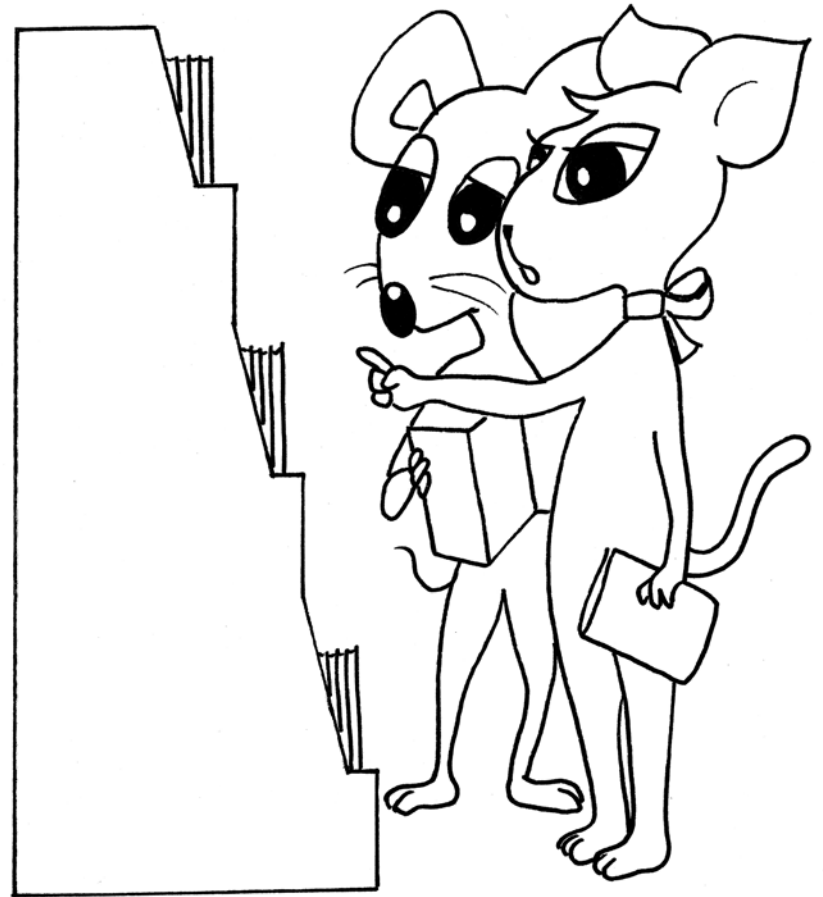
Do you wish to play with us?”

The zebra looks like Zip.”

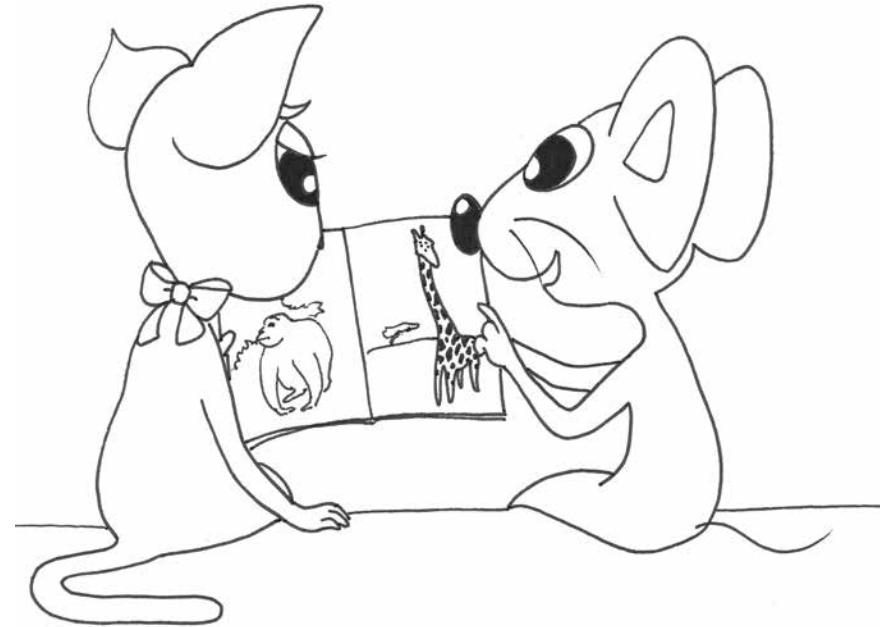


“I see them. They are not far.
Jog up that path and you will see them.”

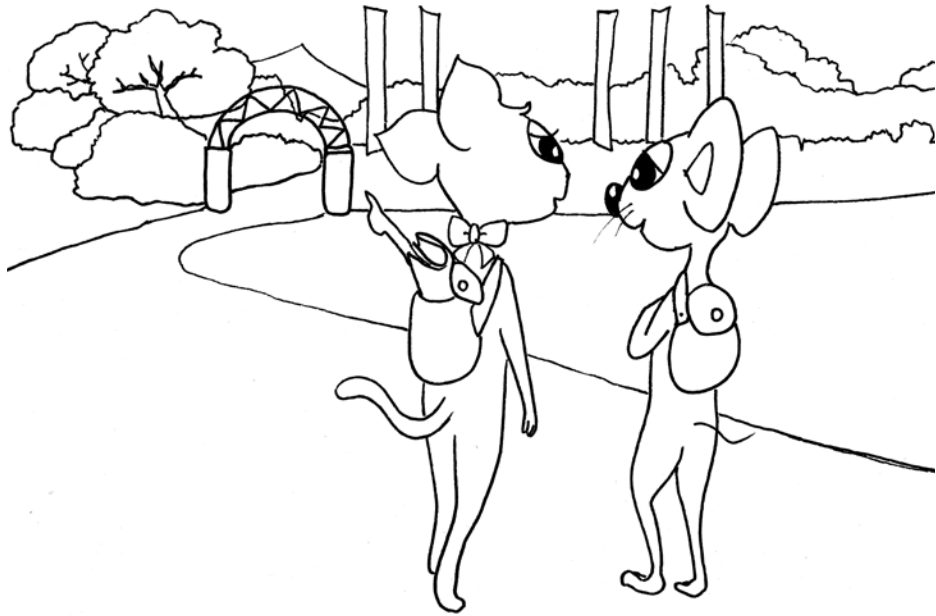




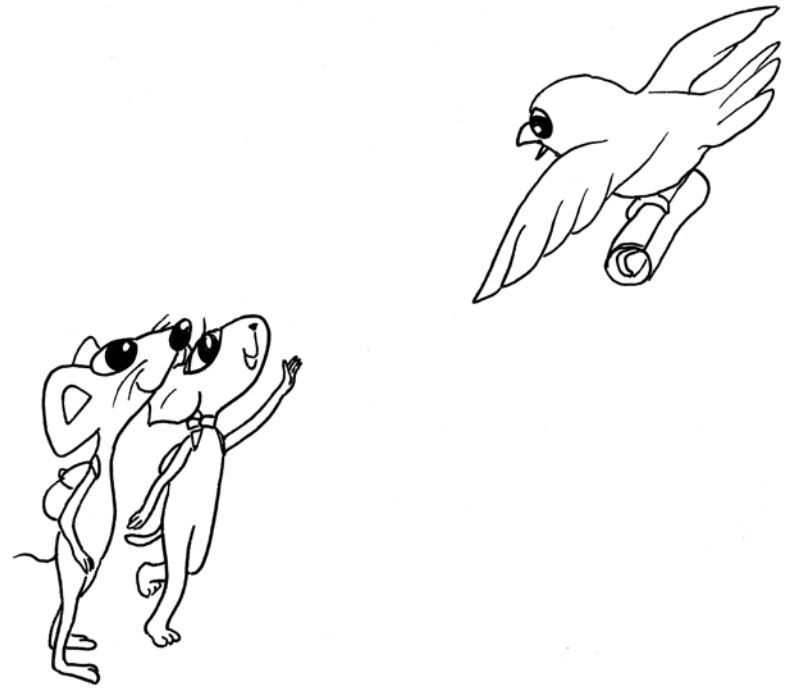
“Where can we see Zip the Zebra?

Zip and Ann.”



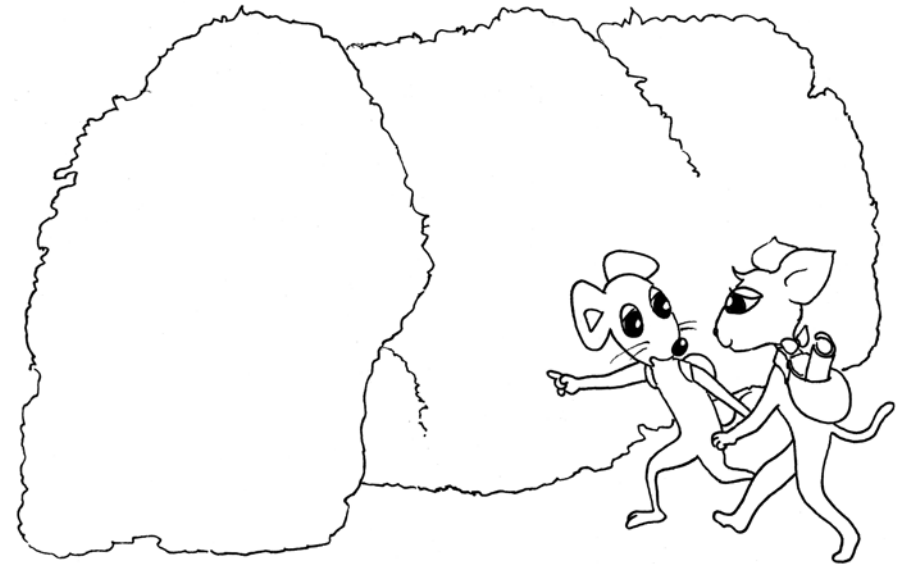
“Where is the zoo? Is it far?” Says Mat.
“Look, there it is,” says Kit.



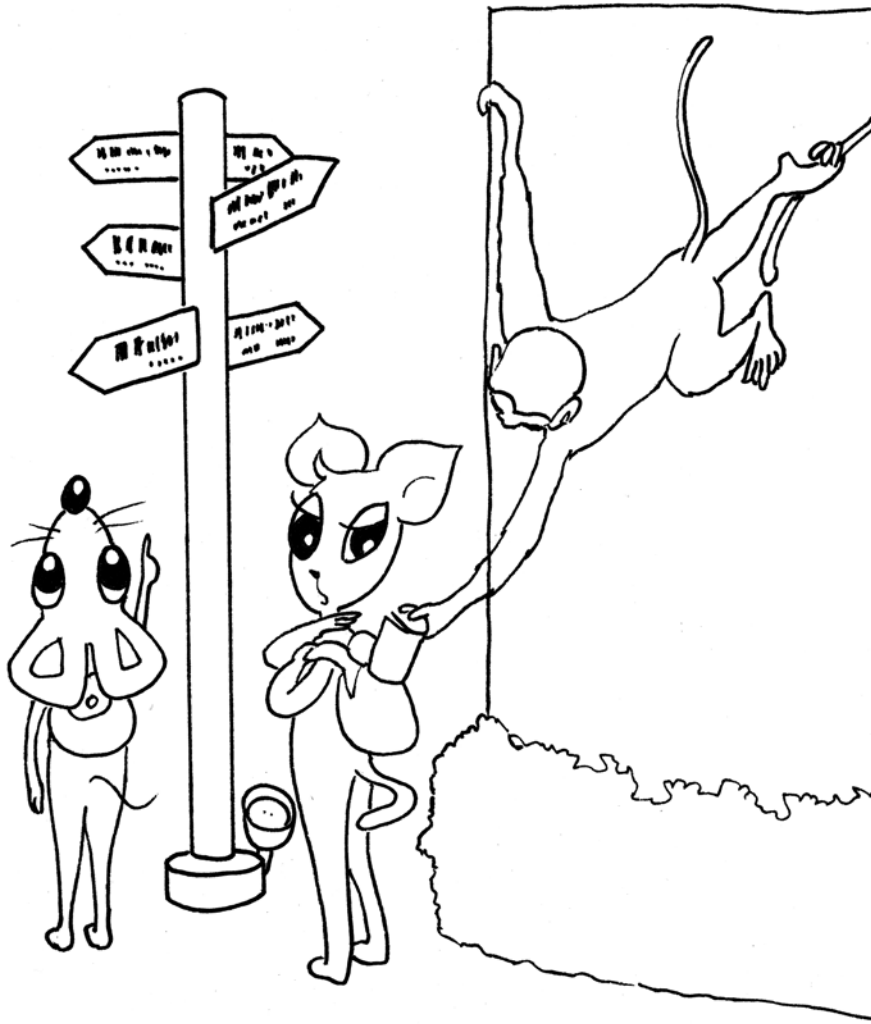
Then they see a bird fly in the sky.

They ran to the hole and into the zoo.

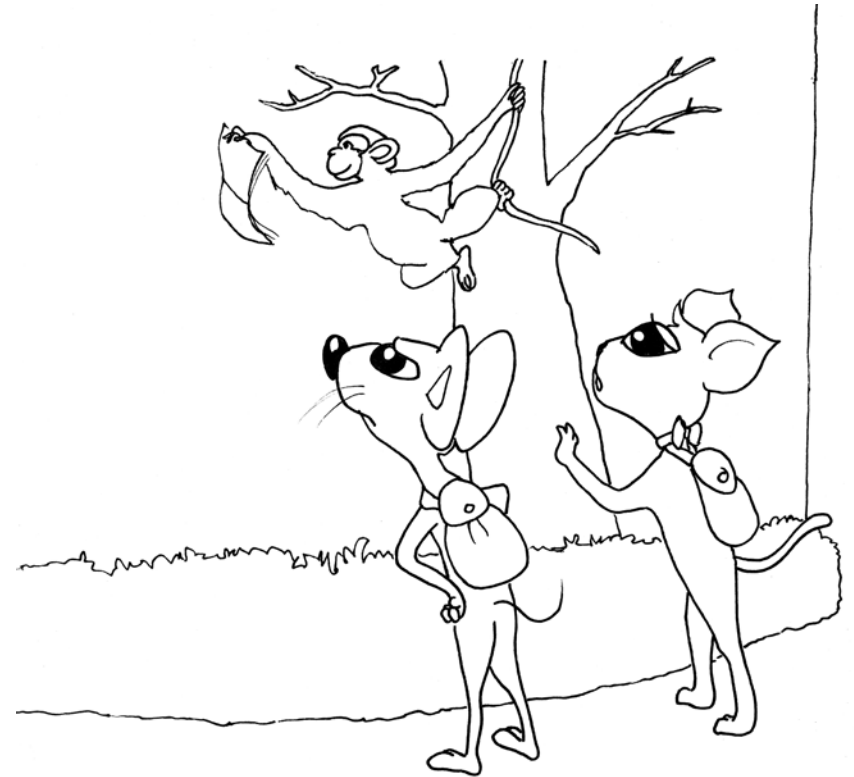


“The zoo is very big.
