
1. page 2: What animal does Phil want to see at the zoo?



When will we see the giraffe?”




“What is that in your book, Sam?”

“You can see a giraffe in the city zoo.”




“We will go to the zoo today,” says Sam.

“Why did you let him go?


He is too small. He will get lost.

“He ran that way to see the giant panda.”




“Which way do we go to see the giant?”

The giant panda is that way.”




“What was your wish, Phil?”

What is your wish?”


“I wish that you do not get lost in
