Story Questions (Comprehension)

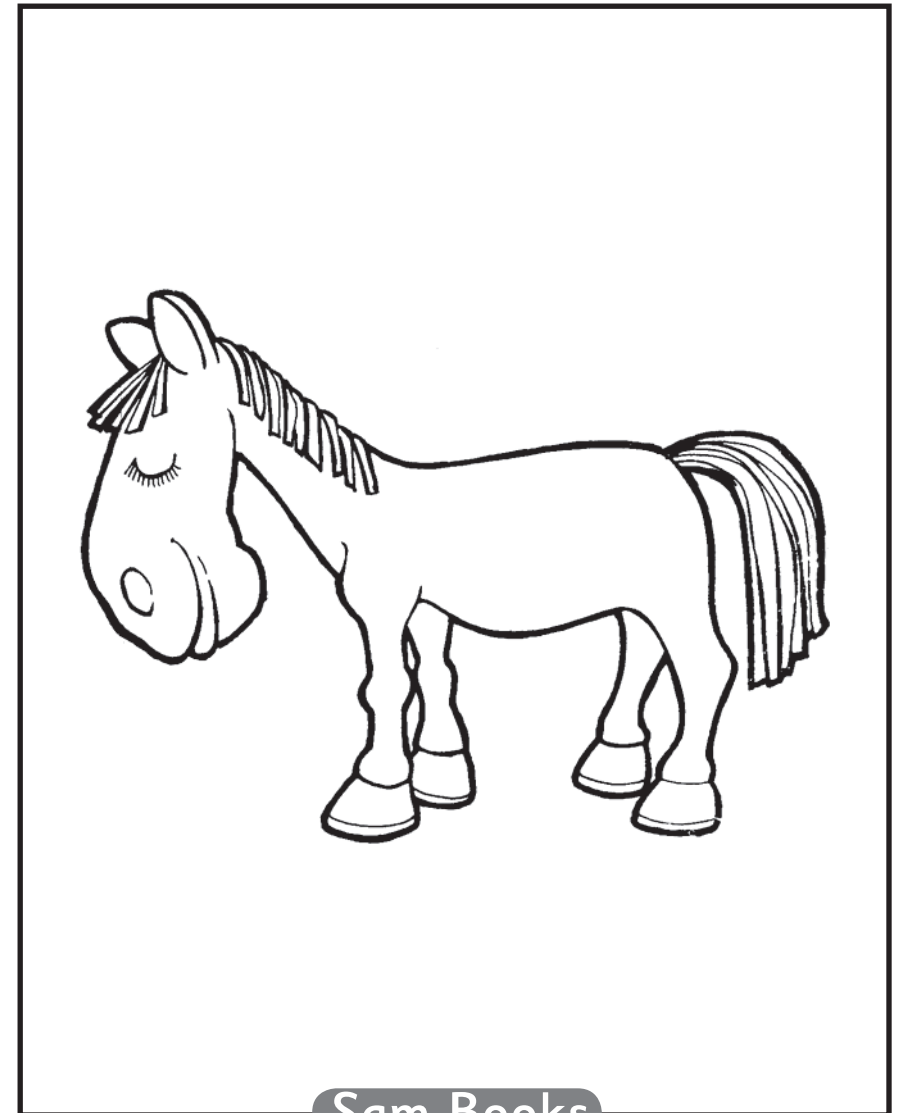
1. page 3: Why is Sid mad at Mat?
