### Plot Summary

5. page 11: What happens to Mit?

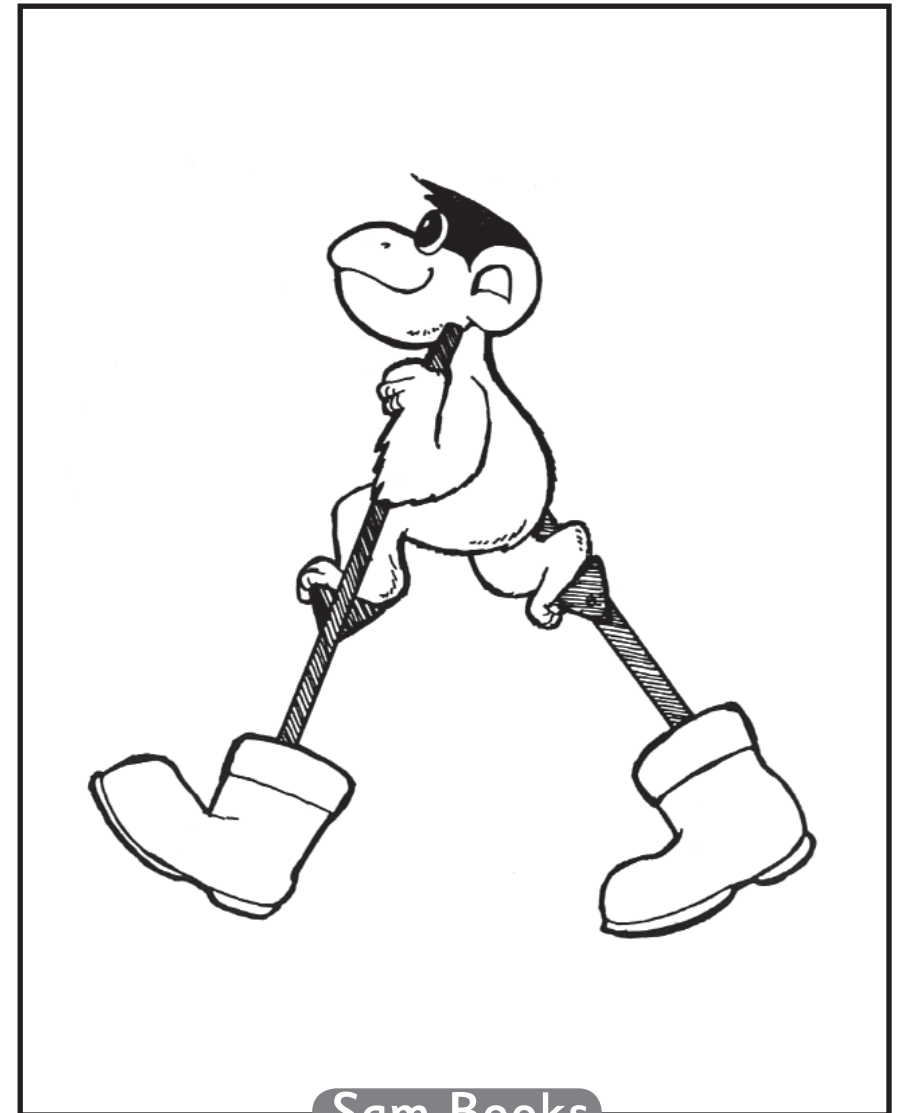
Each new word throughout the program is repeated at least five times in the book in which it first appears and five more times in the next ten books.

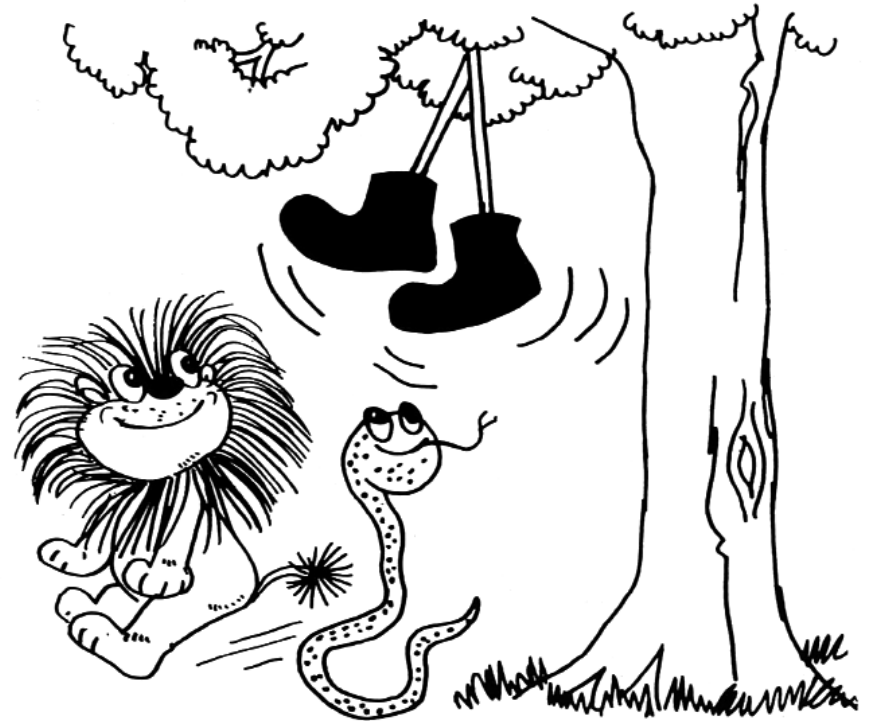
Sam sits.

“What is that?”



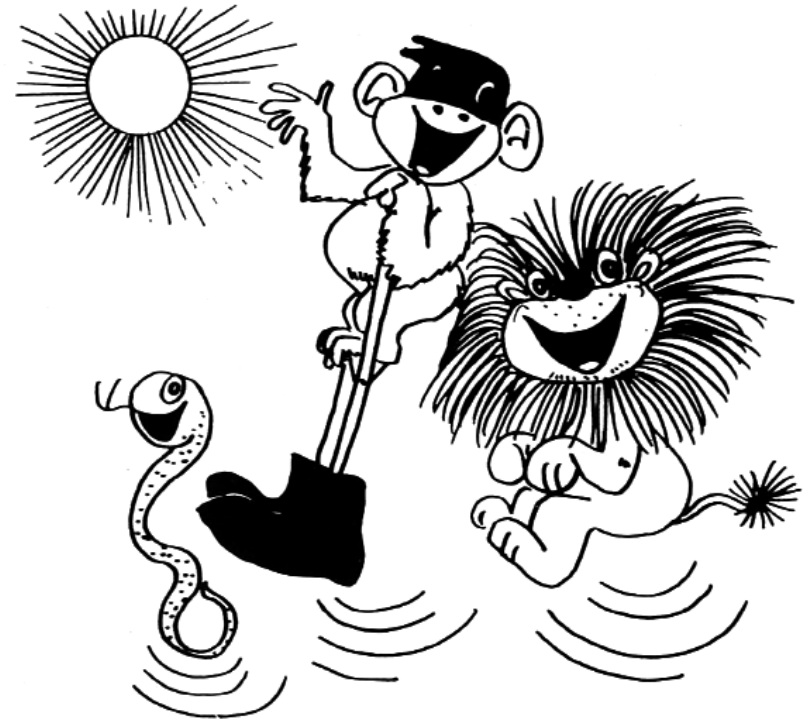
“Run, Sis, run!
