Each new word throughout the program is repeated at least five times in the book in which it first appears and five more times in the next ten books.

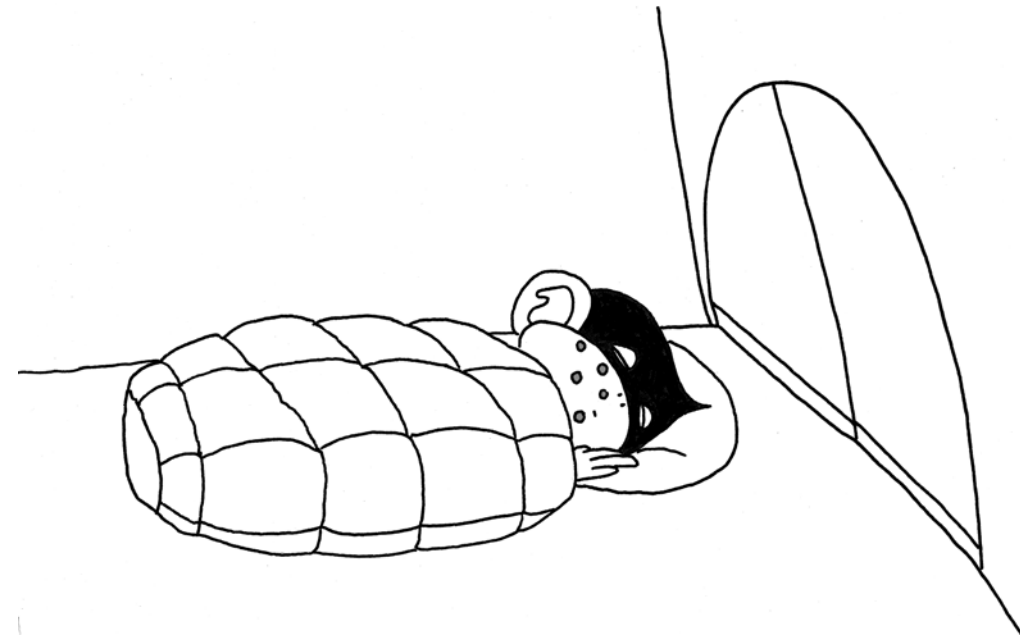

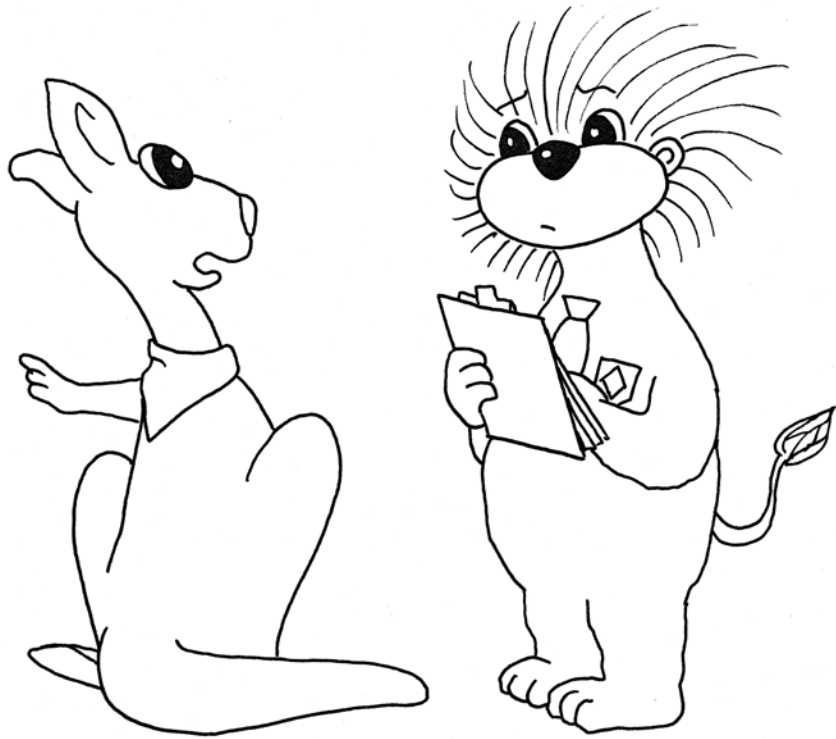

Mat did it,” said Sam.



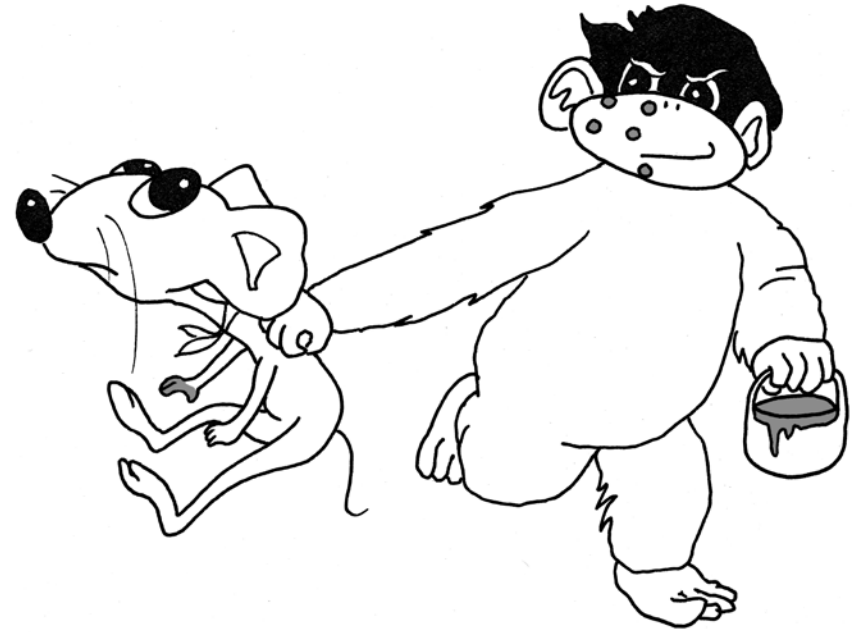
“Mat set the red spots on Mit’s chin.  
He set the red spots on his cheek.”



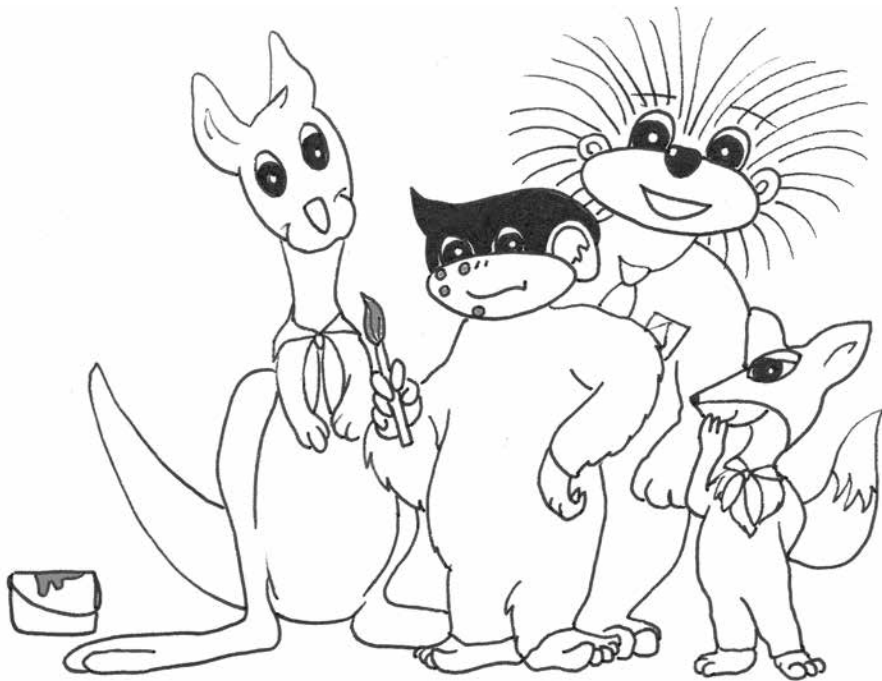
“Mit, it was Mat. His hand is red.
