Story Questions (Comprehension)


1. page 1: Why does Sam ask his friends to go jogging?


“We will jog and jump.

Then we will all be fit and well.”




“This is a big path.

We can not get lost on this path.”




“Let us all jog up the path.

says Max.




Then they get into the sacks.

He gets the cup.




“I can not see Mit.
I see his hat on the path.”




“Mit is lost up the path.
