- 17 A. The Navajo Nation Council is the governing body of the Navajo Nation. 2 N.N.C.

19 B. A proposed resolution requiring final action by the Navajo Nation Council shall be
20 assigned to the Naabik'iyáti' Committee. 2 N.N.C. §164(A)(9).

22 **SECTION TWO. FINDINGS**

- 23 A. The Navajo Nation Code provides, “[t]he President of the Navajo Nation shall
24 employ an Executive Director of the [Navajo Telecommunication Regulatory]
25 Commission who shall serve at the pleasure of the President of the Navajo Nation and
26 be subject to confirmation by the Government Services Committee of the Navajo
27 Nation Council.” 2 N.N.C. §3455.
28 B. References in the Navajo Nation Code to the Government Services Committee, “shall
29 mean the Naabik'iyáti' Committee, unless the amendments enacted herein or the

1 context of previous law indicates otherwise.” Council Resolution CO-45-12, Section
2 5.

3 C. The Navajo Nation President appoints Christopher Becenti as the Executive Director
4 of the Navajo Nation Telecommunication Regulatory Commission. Mr. Becenti’s

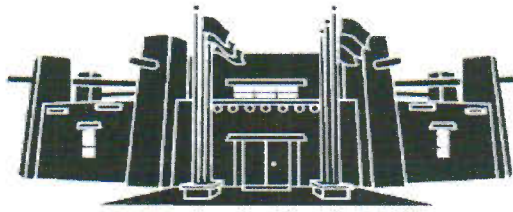


