The Diversity Index, which measures the probability that two people from the same area will be from different race/ethnic groups, is 81.2 in the identified area, compared to 65.1 for the U.S. as a whole.

Currently, 44.1% of the 538,770 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 41.7%, renter occupied; and 14.2% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.3% are renter occupied; and 11.3% are vacant. In 2010, there were 473,559 housing units in the area - 43.7% owner occupied, 40.3% renter occupied, and 16.0% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 5.90%. Median home value in the area is \$313,569, compared to a median home value of \$235,127 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.31% annually to \$351,501.
