## Registration Information



### PAYMENT POLICY

#### Weekly Auto Payments

Payments for child care will be processed via a weekly auto draft. On the registration form you will be asked to provide credit card or bank account information which will be automatically charged every Monday. All fees are non-refundable. Insufficient funds may result in a fee.



### SCHEDULE CHANGES

### WISCONSIN SHARES

Wisconsin Shares is a Child Care Subsidy Program that authorizes funding for a parent to pay a portion of child care fees by using their MyWICildCare EBT card. If a registration form is submitted but the child is not yet approved for Wisconsin Shares, the child will not be registered until the approval has gone through. On the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, funds will be loaded onto the MyWICildCare EBT card and must be processed by the parent for payment to the YMCA by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month, after which the billing office will be able to inform the parent of the remaining balance owed for that month. WI Shares payments that are not made by the 5<sup>th</sup> of the month are subject to a late fee. The remaining parent share will be divided into 3 equal installments which will be bank drafted on the 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Mondays of the month. Child care authorizations must be in place and current before the child can be registered and attend the program.

### ANNUAL CAMPAIGN SCHOLARSHIP

The Y has a financial assistance program that awards a percentage off of child care fees to qualifying families based on income. To qualify for a scholarship, families must first apply for Wisconsin Shares. Please note that child care scholarships are different than membership scholarships. ### ADMISSION POLICY/SPECIAL NEEDS

Y Child Care Programs are open to children of all abilities. Parents have a duty to disclose significant medical, physical or behavioral needs at the time of enrollment. Due to the format of our Child Care Programs, the Y is unable to provide one-on-one care. If your child has unique needs that require a more specific type of accommodation, a meeting must be scheduled with the Leadership Team a minimum of 2 weeks prior to attending the program. This allows us to identify the most effective ways of serving you and your child. Children are still expected to maintain the standards of the Child Care Program to the best of their ability. Any disciplinary actions that would be required would take their ability into account.



### FREE FAMILY MEMBERSHIP

Children who are enrolled full time (5 days a week) in our Child Care Program are eligible for a free family membership. By becoming a Y member, you receive discounts on programs and priority registration for swim lessons, sports and more. Your site director will provide directions to enroll in your family membership. Please contact the Membership Director at your local branch with questions.

## WHY THE Y?



### Digital App

Daily Connect is an app where you can receive real-time updates and pictures on how your child's day is going. You can send messages to your child's teacher, and the teachers are also able to send messages back to you for easy communication throughout the day.



### Meals Included

Breakfast, lunch, and snack that meet the Child and Adult Care Food Program requirements are included with the weekly child care fee.



### Formula and Baby Food Included

The Y provides Parents Choice Formula (Walmart brand) and cereal along with Gerber baby food for children under 1 year of age.



### Preschool Curriculum

The child care program uses a play-based curriculum. There are weekly themes in which the teachers plan activities that meet the developmental levels of all children in their classroom.



### Safety

The safety of your child is our number one priority at the Y. All staff are background checked and receive training on child abuse prevention. We have secured centers with keypad entry and fenced in playgrounds.



### Access to a Variety of Activities

Children learn best through playing. Here at the Y we provide access to a gym or large motor room to allow children the room to explore and play. For an additional fee, children also have access to swim lessons and youth enrichment classes during child care hours.\*

### Sibling Discount

Families with multiple children enrolled in our licensed child care or school age programs, may be eligible for a discount.
